*\*Due to the specific requirements of the Elite category, a dog must enter a minimum of three legs to attend this category. A dog moving up will be based on max capacity and at the discretion of the judges.*

*There will be limited spots in the WDX & WDE categories for time reasons. Ensure you are registering quickly to secure a spot.*

**Entries Open starting Tuesday, July 30 2024 at 7:00 PM MDT:** Leanna Belt, Test Secretary. [Dogshow.ca](http://Dogshow.ca) will be the only entry format for this event.

**Entries close 7:00 P.M, Tuesday, August 6, 2024.** The running order will be posted no later than Wednesday, August 14, 2024.

**TCN Number:** (Previously Listing fees) A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) has been established by The Canadian Kennel Club and **MUST ACCOMPANY** the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This fee is \$10.50 (incl GST) per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records. Please visit [www.CKC.ca](http://www.CKC.ca) to obtain your TCN

All entries for the Water Test are accepted on condition that the GSPFCA, its officials and members, and the land owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this water test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Test Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

#### TEST INFORMATION:

- **Birds** – WDJ will be the only class using **Chukar Partridge** in their water event. All other classes will use Duck and only Duck due to the launch distances required in those levels.
- Total entries will be limited to the **number of dogs** that can be run in the judging time. Entries will close and a waiting list will be started once this limit is reached.
- **Starting times** will be announced. (Earliest start will be 8:30 am. on the Saturday and Sunday)
- Bitches **in season** will not be permitted due to the overlap in courses.
- **Training or exercising** of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday until completion of judging on Sunday). The dog may be wet down for heat reasons at a designated area but objects including bumpers are not to be used.
- **Smoking** is prohibited except in parked vehicles.
- **Accommodation:** There is no camping on the grounds permitted outside of judges and organizers. There are various campgrounds in the area and hotel accommodations in Calgary, Airdrie, Balzac, and Irricana.
- **Food:** There will be no food or beverages available for participants. Please bring your own
- **Prizes** - Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test – no ribbons will be mailed
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. 1. There will be no hospitality or concession food available. Food will be supplied for all judges and workers.
2. Bring water and food for yourself and your dogs.
3. The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicle.
4. If your dog poops, unless it is in long grass, please scoop and dispose in the provided garbage bags or consider packing out your own refuse.
