

PLEASE NOTE: If you enter via email you must bring your original entry form(s) and signed waiver to the trial or you will not be able to compete.

Entry Fees: \$20.00 1st dog per CAP test, \$17.00 2nd and subsequent dog per CAP test. (Includes CKC Recording Fee).

Other Fees: \$10.50 CKC listing fee per event for all non-CKC registered dogs (includes 5% GST). Dog must be eligible for registration but yet have been registered.

Make cheques payable to Saluki Club of Canada. Any overpayment of entry fees is considered a donation. Credit Cards or Postdated Cheques will be not be accepted. \$25.00 fee for returned cheques.

Directions to The Field:

The field is about 4 km southeast of Delisle, at the intersection of Range Road 3084 (Durham Road) and Township Road 342. If you are coming north from Calgary on #7, turn Right on #766 just as you are about to leave Delisle, and right at the first turn past the feedlot. The Pattison farm (big red barn, metal roof) is the first place you come to; the field is across the road from the buildings, on the right.

If you are coming from Saskatoon on #7, turn left about 10 km past Vanscoy, onto Durham Road. The Pattison farm is the second place you come to (the first is a house very close to the highway).

Additional Information:

- Delisle Veterinary Clinic is within easy access from the field.
- The field is rough hay. It is away from roads, but is not fenced.
- Camping on the field is permitted. There will be a port-a-potty on site.
- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run. Additionally, the field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- Dogs may run with muzzles & catch collars at the handler's discretion. Catch collars must be snug and be free of any item which may become tangled in the line. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed on the premises of this event.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last test
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- Visit these websites for dog friendly accommodations in Delisle or Saskatoon www.doginmysuitcase.com, www.travelpets.com, www.officialpethotels.com. Book early, do not leave your dog unattended and remember to "Stoop & Scoop".
- Due to COVID-19 health & safety guidelines, a canteen will NOT be available. Please bring your own food and water. Also please bring your own shade as there is no shade on the field.

<u>Exhibitors Please Note</u>: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CKC CHASE ABILITY PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Participants: Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have an Event Registration Number (ERN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed-breed. Note: Only dogs eligible for a CKC# or an ERN# can be entered as listed. Sighthounds are more than welcome at these events.

Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. An inspection committee, consisting of two experienced persons, shall inspect each entry for lameness, fitness to participate and females in season. If in the opinion of the committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female is in season, it shall not be allowed to participate and the entry fees shall be refunded.

A dog may enter only once per event. Running order determined day of based on the entries received. Multiple entries from the same owner will be separated in the running order. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. To earn a Pass a dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. If there is a question as to which course a dog will run the judge will decide.

300 YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. Dogs will run one loop.

600 YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. Dogs will run both loops.

On Saturday the course will be reversed for the second event. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

CAP RIBBONS AND TITLES: Gold qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs passing their test.

There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program.

They are: **Chase Ability** (CA) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges.

Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)

Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc)

PHYSICAL DISTANCING/MASKS: The Provincial physical distancing guideline of maintaining a minimum of 6 feet or 3 meters distance must be adhered to at these events by volunteers and participants. We are asking that you stay in or near your vehicle except when running or exercising a dog. In situations such as dog inspections, handlers meetings, participants may find it necessary to be in closer proximity. In these cases, the wearing of a mask will be required. Participants must provide their own mask or other suitable face covering.

Failure to respect physical distancing guidelines as noted above will result in excusal from the event and event precincts without refund of entry fees.

FOOD: To comply with health and safety guidelines related to COVID-19, there will be no food or water provided on site. Participants will need to bring their own food/refreshments.

WELLNESS: If on the days leading up to, or the day of these events you or any member of your household are exhibiting any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19, please refrain from attending these events. Entry withdrawals due to illness will be refunded in full.

COVID REFUND POLICY: In the event that provincial regulations change and force the cancellation of these events prior to the day of the event, entry fees will be refunded.


