Novice/Open/Excellent/Master (C-I-E)	\$35.00/each component
All 3 components (must be in the same class)	\$95.00
Limited entries are reserved for volunteers.	

Day of Trial Entries: Day of trial entries will be accepted as space allows and must be submitted prior to the judges briefing. Day of entries shall be \$40.00 per component and only cash will be accepted on the day of the trial.

Moving-Up (CKC Rules 6.9.1): As per CKC rules/regulations a dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the **SCHEDULE PERMITS**.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, cheques will not be accepted.

No Entry Will Be Accepted Without Payment in Full: Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this Trial is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Rosettes & Prizes: Rosettes will be awarded to all New Novice, Open, Excellent and Master Titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive flat ribbons. A ribbon is not guaranteed for day of entries, however any ribbons earned will be sent out post-trial if required.

There Will Be No Refunds on Duplicate or Overpayment Entries: Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Scent Detection comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial. The American Staffordshire Terrier Club of Canada will refund entry, recording and listing fees (not the 10% dog show program service fee) if the above conditions are met.

Bitches In Season: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

Handlers With Multiple Dogs: Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than one dog in the same class / components. i.e.: Two novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial. The handler may enter one dog in Instinct, and one dog in Novice as an alternative.

Venue Site: No indoor kenneling. These Trials will be run rain, snow, or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test (where off leash searches are permitted). The use of non-trial odor is NOT permitted on the venue site. Remember that this is a facility used by a business. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event. Stairs during the trial may need to be used to access search areas. Please inform the club if you need assistance. Washroom facilities are available indoors.

CKC Rules & Regulations: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair/Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred." It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

Non-Member Participant Fees: The CKC has a tracking fee for non- members. Please refer to the information about this policy on the CKC website:

Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10.50) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Covid Policy (if applicable) Any handler unable to attend these trials due to exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, after the entries close must contact the trial secretary so they may try fill the available spaces. If those spaces are filled, you will receive a refund if spaces or not sold you will forfeit your entry to astccanada@gmail.com.

Wait List: If the trial fills a waitlist will be maintained. Should a space become available it will be offered in the order their registration was received.
