ENTRY FEES: \$85.00 per dog/Per Trial/UTD \$100.00 per dog/Per Trial/UTDX

NOTE – A TD title or a UTD Pre-Test Certificate is a prerequisite for entering UTD tests. An original, signed copy of the certificate must be received by the event secretary by the test closing date. The name of the person certifying the dog will be included with the dog's information in the catalogue. The certificate will be returned to each entrant who does not participate in the test. **Consult the CKC Tracking Rules for the prerequisites for the UTD Test**

C.K.C. LISTING FEES: \$10.00 + GST per dog/Per Trial

If a dog is not registered individually with the CKC it may be entered at a tracking test as a "listed" dog, provided that: (a) If born in Canada, it is of a litter which is eligible for CKC registration. (b) If not born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration in the records of the CKC. (c) If foreign born and owned, it obtains an Event Registration Number (ERN) or CKC registration number, from the CKC within 30 days of the first test entered.

(d) It is not a designated Miscellaneous Class Breed. The listing fee must accompany the entry (see rule 6.1.2).

ENTRIES CLOSE: Tuesday August 31, 2021 AT 6:00 pm. The Club cannot accept entries delivered after this date and time. Any entries received after the closing date will be discarded. **All duplicate entries received for the same dog in one event will be discarded. Multiple entries in one envelope will NOT be accepted** (see rule 6.1.19). **SEND ENTRIES BY MAIL ONLY** to the Test Secretary at the address indicated on Premium cover. No courier, emailed, faxed or hand delivered entries will be accepted. The Test Secretary will notify the entrant by email on the day the entry is received.

PAYMENT: Please make all cheques payable to **Wild Rose Tracking Club**. Fees must accompany each entry. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog where a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. **NOTE:** There will be a \$50.00 service charge on all **NSF** cheques received. Tendering an **NSF** cheque shall be considered **NON-PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES** and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club.

ENTRY DRAW: A random entry draw will take place on **Wednesday, September 1, 2021 at 1:00 pm.** at 15608 - 132 Street NW, Edmonton AB. The entry draw will follow the draw procedure as outlined per rule 2.2.4. Entrants will be notified as to their position in the test or on an alternate list by email following the entry draw.

CLUB WORKER DRAW: At the entry draw one UTD track in each trial will be reserved for a "Club Worker" as defined by the Wild Rose Tracking Club (see rule 6.6.2).

REFUNDS: Withdrawn entries after closing date will only be refunded where there is an "Alternate" available who chooses to fill that assigned entrant's vacancy on test day. Alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and advised of the opening. They may choose to accept the spot and become responsible for the entry fee or decline and bear no financial obligation. Anyone on the "Alternate List" may request a refund at any time prior to test day. Entries will be refunded within 10 days of the test date to those on the alternate list that did not participate in the test.

RENDEZVOUS LOCATION: Rendezvous location will be indicated in the email sent indicating the

outcome of the entry draw.

TRACK DRAW TRIAL 1: Draw for both the UTD and UTDX tests will take place at the rendezvous location at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday September 11, 2021.

TRACK DRAW TRIAL 2: Draw for both the UTD and UTDX tests will take place at the rendezvous location at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday September 12, 2021.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season will be permitted to compete but will be assigned the last track. Please advise the Test Secretary as soon as possible if your bitch is in season for the test.

PLEASE NOTE TO ALL NON-MEMBERS OF THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB: Effective January 1st, 2011 an annual non-member participation fee for all awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian nonmember of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee \$63.90 + 5% GST. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and not dogs co-owned by a CKC member. Entries shall not be accepted from any person who is not in good standing with the Canadian Kennel Club on the day of entries closing.

US EXHIBITORS: U.S. entrants may pay fees by money order payable in Canadian funds OR by personal cheque in U.S. funds for the full amount of the fees. Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted and please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as these will not be accepted. Bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds are the best choice. Please make bank draft, cheque, or money order payable to Wild Rose Tracking Club.

PRIZES: A ribbon stating "Passed UTD" or "Passed UTDX" will be awarded to dogs earning these titles.

RULE 14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

COMPLAINTS: Upon receipt of a complaint, the Tracking Test Committee of the test-giving club shall conduct an investigation as soon as possible thereafter, but in any event, within 14 days of receipt, and shall conduct a hearing in accordance with the procedure for conducting a Tracking Test Committee hearing as provided in these rules and regulations.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: The Wild Rose Tracking Club will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of the dogs competing, but will not be held responsible for the loss, damage, or injury to dogs or handlers and their property. Wild Rose Tracking Club members, volunteers and the land owners will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. By entering this Test each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the Test and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) and/or leasee(s) of any property upon which the Test may be held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising

out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. My signature on the entry form indicates that I understand and agree to the above and to abide by rules of the current Official CKC Rules and Regulations as well as rules set forth by the Wild Rose Tracking Club concerning this event

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: It is the **responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules** pertaining to the event in which they are competing. **New Tracking Test Rules & Regulations were published effective January 1, 2020.**

GENERAL:

1. Only dogs entered in the trial will be allowed on the test grounds. All dogs must be on leash and under control at all times. Do not leave dogs unattended. Please pick up after your dog.
2. There will be **NO** prong, pinch or electric shock collars allowed on the test grounds.
3. Spectators will be expected to obey any instructions given by the Test Chair. Special procedures may be in place to ensure compliance with Covid-19 related Public Health measures.
4. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. EXHIBITORS MUST BE PRESENT WHEN IT IS THEIR TURN TO RUN THE TRACK. Exhibitors that are not present when their name is called will be disqualified.
5. Please respect landowner's property. It is because of their generosity that we are able to host these trials.
