Tendering of a NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment and such entries will be rejected. Post-dated cheques are not acceptable. FAX entries and/or Credit Card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. NSF cheques or Credit Card entries whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of **\$30.00** for each transaction declined. To ensure your entries are received on time it is suggested that you mail at least 15 days prior to the closing date of Wednesday, May 15, 2013 midnight. The Show Secretary will not accept telephone or email entries. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees or after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. Entries must be received by the Show Secretary prior to closing date. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but must be followed up in writing to reach the Show Secretary by closing day (mail, email, fax) ***A service charge of 10% of total charges will be assessed on all credit card charges including on-line, fax and post entries using a credit card for payment.**

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS

Please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in CANADIAN FUNDS. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in US funds for the full amount of the entry. DISCOUNTED CHEQUES OR MONEY ORDERS WILL NOT BE HONOURED. Please do not send personal cheques marked 'payable in Canadian Funds' or 'At par'. Funds owing due to fluctuating exchange rate will be collected at Show Secretary's desk prior to the Show. Your cooperation is appreciated.

ERN (EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER)

Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN. This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. **To obtain an ERN, simply do the following:** send to CKC, a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, i.e. AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number. Payment must be included with the application. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you. Faxed requests will be accepted. CKC Fax: 416-675-6506. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholders name and signature. The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as 'listed', however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellations of any wins, awards, and scores. **ERN Application forms available at the Show Secretary's desk.**

PEN (PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER)

To apply for or to obtain, information on the PEN contact the Shows and Trials Division at the Canadian Kennel Club or visit their web site at www.ckc.ca – on line forms. **PEN Application forms available at the Show Secretary's desk.**

CANADIAN NON-MEMBER TRACKING FEE

Applies only to dogs wholly owned by a Canadian non CKC Member(s) and are not applicable to CKC members. An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the current ERN fee. (\$57.60 Can.). In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. **Non-member participation fee application forms available at the Show Secretary's desk.**

ALL BREED PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES Friday - 1 hour after BIS

All puppies must be six months to twelve months of age to compete and must also be entered in one of the regular breed classes on the day of the Sweepstakes. For judging, the puppies will be divided into the following classes:

Jr. Puppy, Male	6 - 9 months	Sr. Puppy, Male	9 - 12 months
Jr. Puppy, Female	6 - 9 months	Sr. Puppy, Female	9 - 12 months

JUDGE: TBA

Final judging: The 1st place puppy from each of the above classes will be brought together for the final placings of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th.

Senior Open	As per Senior Novice & have won 6 First places in the same class with competition or has completed Intermediate Open and is confident to compete at this level.

Junior Handling is open to all persons from four (4) years up to but not including eighteen (18) years of age on the date of the competition. All dogs must also be entered in a Regular Class at the all breed show on Saturday, June 8th, 2013 but need not be owned by the Junior. Trophies and rosettes will be awarded for FIRST in each Class (except Pee Wee class, who will receive Participant ribbons or rosettes) and for BEST OVERALL HANDLER and RESERVE BEST OVERALL HANDLER.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

THE FOLLOWING REGULAR CKC CLASSES (DIVIDED BY SEX) WILL BE OFFERED.

BABY PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. There are no points awarded for these classes.

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 MONTH CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS – This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. **(Champions of any country excluded)**

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS – This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by the owner/breeder. The handler **must** be the owner/co-owner **and** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – This class shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status.

EXHIBITION ONLY – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **may not compete** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY.

BRACE (SATURDAY ONLY) - Two dogs of the same breed, (not necessarily the same sex) handled by 1 person on 1 lead. Judged AFTER BOB and AFTER Group but **BEFORE BIS**. Should be judged as an identical pair, same colour, size, gait, and same stride. Should appear as a dog and its shadow.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded **WINNERS** at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to dog awarded. **WINNERS** shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points. The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded **WINNERS** also places in the **GROUP** as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show**.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: **(a)** earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and **(b)** be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number and **(c)** have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

BEST PUPPY IN BREED – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is **NOT** required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS – A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20** of the **Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to “Specials Only” providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show** by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a **LISTED** dog. Listing fees, however, **WILL NOT** be refunded.

CKC Rule (8.2.5) An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Although adapted from the CKC Obedience Rules & Regulations, this list is a summary which is not meant to replace reading of the CKC Obedience Rules & Regulations.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

PRE-NOVICE (PCD) (Transition Class)-For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of PCD or a CD in any country. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog for Group Exercise. This is an elective class and is not a requirement to enter Novice A or B. **Not eligible for High In Trial.**

NOVICE A – For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has not earned a CD or comparable title in any country. Only 1 dog per handler in this class and handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family. This class is not for professional handlers, trainers or persons who have exhibited a dog to its **CDX**.

NOVICE B - For dogs who meet requirements for Novice A, however may be handled by any person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class. Separate handlers are required for the Group Exercises.

NOVICE C (Transition Class) - For any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE (CDI) (Transition Class)-For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of CD, CDX, UD and any other advanced obedience title in Canada. May be handled by any person and a person may enter more than one dog however same handler must handle dog in all 6 exercises. This is an elective class and not a requirement. **Not eligible for High In Trial.**

OPEN A-For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of CD but not CDX. Only 1 dog per handler in this class and handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family. This class is not for professional handlers, trainers or persons who have exhibited a dog to its UD. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

OPEN B- For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of CD, CDX, or UD, Dog may be handled by any person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class. Separate handlers are required for the Group Exercises.

Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approx 30 minutes prior to judging.

UTILITY A- For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of CDX but not earned the title of U.D. No person who has earned a **MOTCH** title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

UTILITY B- For any dog of recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of CDX or UD. Dog may be handled by any person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class. **Exercises will be done in random order.** Order will be posted approx 30 minutes prior to judging.

BRACE- Open to any 2 dogs of any breed and of either sex that has attained not less than a CD title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed. Performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the 2 dogs as though they were one. Exhibitors may enter more than one brace in this class, but must have a separate handler for each brace in the Long Sit & Down exercises. Unofficial class.

NOTICE TO OBEDIENCE EXHIBITORS

Not all changes can be or are posted in this premium list. It is strongly recommended that all obedience exhibitors acquire the most recent Obedience Trials Rule Book from the Canadian Kennel Club.

MAJOR CLASS CHANGES: **Pre-Novice** – Deleted: Circle Left and Circle Right. Added: Figure 8. Posts to be 12 feet apart. **Novice A** – No person who has previously exhibited a dog that has earned a **CDX** title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. Stand for examination will be done off leash. **Novice Intermediate** – Drop from heel has been moved to follow Stand for Examination. Both a command and signal are allowed for the drop. Honour Exercise removed; replaced with Recall over the High Jump holding the Dumbbell.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Only approved CKC collars will be allowed in the precincts of the Trials. Correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. However Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the “A” class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding “B” class **up to one hour before the start of the trial.** The YKC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors IF a dated veterinarian’s certificate stating that the bitch was in season within a 10 day period preceding the trial is produced to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

LIMITED ENTRY (OBEDIENCE / RALLY): Entry in each trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to perform 7 hours (420 minutes) of judging at the rate of 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour and 6 Utility dogs per hour. Once a judge has reached their maximum capacity the entries shall be closed but a reserve list will be created. Handlers will be notified of their position on the reserve list and any entries pulled after closing date due to a bitch coming in season. Their spot may be filled by a competitor on the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Although adapted from the CKC Obedience Rules & Regulations, this list is a summary which is not meant to replace reading of the CKC Rally Obedience Rules & Regulations.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

RALLY NOVICE A – Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has previously exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructs dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY NOVICE B – Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has previously exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructs dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED B – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. Upon completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title, a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has previously exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructs dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT B – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely. Any person is allowed to handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

The distance to be jumped for the broad jump will be set to twice the height required.

GENERAL INFORMATION / SHOW REGULATIONS

1. The show building will be open Thursday June 6TH, 2013 AFTER 2 pm. NO ADMITTANCE prior to 2 pm on Thursday, June 6TH, 2013, NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Venue opens at 6 am Friday, Saturday & Sunday and closes at 10:30 pm Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Exhibitors must vacate the building one hour after Best in Show on Sunday, June 9, 2013.
3. Showers will be available while the building is open. Exhibitors should be aware that facility management personnel may collect a nominal fee. Use of the building is a privilege, please respect the facilities.
4. LOADING /UNLOADING area. 15 Minutes Maximum.
5. Private exercise pens will be allowed only with the permission of the Show Superintendent. Exercise pens MUST have plastic sheeting underneath. If space is limited, exercise pens will have to be taken down during show hours. The Club reserves the right to restrict exhibitors grooming space.
6. Crates will be allowed at ringside during the judging of your specific breed ONLY and MUST be removed immediately after.
7. Exhibitors must exercise their dogs in the designated areas provided. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. .
8. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Please exercise control and restraint over the children in your care while on the show precincts.

9. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
10. EXTENSION CORDS: Please tape down cords to ensure safety of others. Remove tape from floor at end of show and clean your area.
11. Aisles must be kept open at all times to allow everyone easy and speedy exit in case of emergency.
12. Fire Lanes must be kept open at all times. Please be considerate and think defensively.
13. Dogs MUST BE ON LEASH at all times on the show grounds or within the show building.
14. All entries must be complete, including the full name & address of the owner of the dog. The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how and by whom entries were made. Changes or cancellations after closing date are prohibited except according to CKC rules.
15. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the show(s).
16. A judging schedule will be distributed as soon as possible after entries close, by email if one provided, by postal mail if requested and posted on the Club website: www.yukonkennelclub.com.
17. Dogs must be in the show building at least one hour prior to the judging of their breed. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to have their dog(s) at ringside when required for judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. Only dogs entered in the show/trial are allowed in the building.
18. No refund of entry fee will be made if, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Yukon Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show.
19. The Yukon Kennel Club will use due care & diligence to ensure the welfare and safety of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors, vendors or spectators. PLEASE NOTE: Dogs left in the building are at owners/agents' risk. There will be no watchman hired by YKC on duty at night in the show and kennel area.
20. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the YKC Shows & Trials which will be governed by CKC Rules.
21. A JUDGE OR ANY PERSON PARTICIPATING IN ANY CAPACITY AT A DOG SHOW HELD UNDER CKC RULES SHALL NOT BE SUBJECTED TO ANY INDIGNITY OF ANY KIND during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The show superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the discipline committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that the rule has been violated.
22. The YKC is not responsible for contracts made with any vendors.
23. There will be no provision for dogs "In Transit" at this show.
24. All exhibitors, handlers and patrons are expected to know and abide by the CKC Dog Show Rules.
25. No persons or dogs shall be allowed in any part of the building not designated for dog show use.
26. The Mt. Macintyre Recreation Centre is a non-smoking facility. Please abide by this territorial law. There are smoking areas outside the building and ash buckets for your use.

Turn right off Hamilton Blvd. on to Sumanik Drive and into Mt. MacIntyre Rec. Centre and the site of the YKC show.

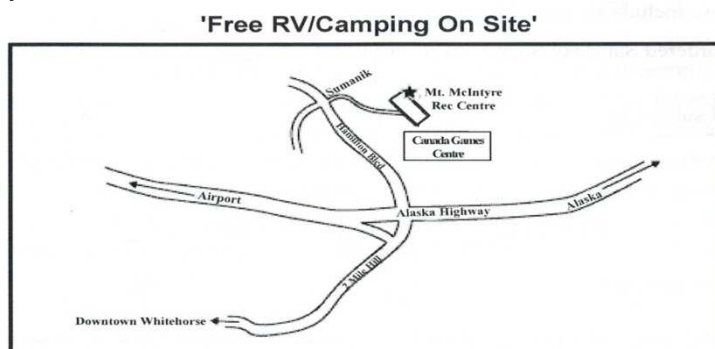
