

## **JUDGING SCHEDULE**

September 2, 2018

East Hants Sportsplex 1076 Hwy 2, Lantz, NS

- Please remember to bring your exhibitors tickets or a list of your armband numbers with you otherwise you will have to go to the catalog to look them up and then go to the end of the line.
- > Judging will start promptly and adhere as closely as possible to this schedule.
- Handlers of several different breeds <u>must</u> arrange for alternate handlers, should judging of their different Breeds conflict. Schedule changes will not be made.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be at ringside when their classes are called. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate dogs. **Judges will not wait for any dog or handler delaying a class.**
- ➤ Time for Conformation Judging is based on 20 25 dogs per hour.
- > No dogs are to be left in the building overnight.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)

Note: The same armband numbers will be used for both Specialties and Halifax Kennel Club events.

## **DIRECTIONS**

Take Exit 8 from Hwy 102 and proceed into Elmsdale (away from superstore). At the traffic lights turn left and go approx 2 km and you will see the sign to the Sportsplex on the left.

CLEANUP: All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean-up on the show site and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling. Anyone caught not cleaning up after their dogs WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM SHOWING their dog(s) or dogs at this event.

This is a new location for us and there are a few rules we are obligated to follow as given to us by the management of the sportsplex.

- NO XPENS ARE PERMITTED!!
- There is to be NO food brought in or consumed within the show premises. All that is allowed in is bottled water.
- It is suggested that all crates have a waterproof covering under it. It would go a long way to show our respect for the venue.
- Please exercise your dogs frequently to avoid accidents in the building.
- Bait is permitted but must not be thrown in the rings. This will be strictly enforced.
- There is RV parking available but no services.
- There are a limited number of large dressing rooms available intside the building with power that are available for rent for \$100 for the weekend.
- For those with a large amount of gear to unload please use the large double doors that are around the back of the building. It will make your job easier.
- Power is limited in the building and will require long extension cords with only one cord per outlet and no sharing of the cord because of the amount of power used by dryers. We urge people requiring significant amounts of power for long term use to rent a dressing room. They are large enough to share and have ample power.
