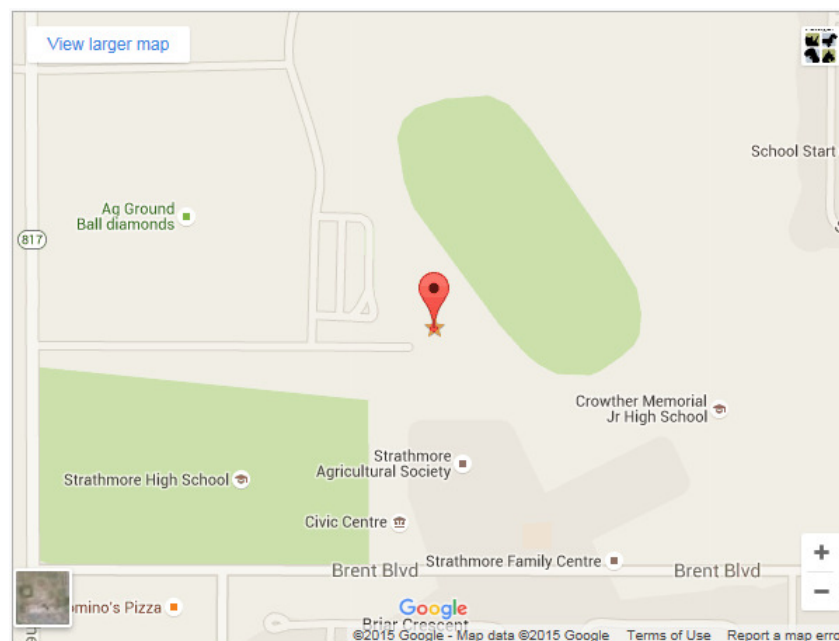
Exercise areas will be setup outside the building during this workshop. Please pick up after your dog.
