As per CARO rules, 10 minutes/20 participants will be allowed for competitors to walk the course prior to each event, except for the 'C' classes where the walkthrough is 2 minutes for 10-12 participants. The judge will provide a briefing prior to each course, and will be on hand to answer questions during the walk-through.

Please Note: Food or toys, if used, MUST be in the RIGHT-HAND POCKET of the handler, <u>OUT OF SIGHT</u>. NO TREAT/BAIT BAGS. NO ACTIVE TOYS (clickers, laser, squeak toys, etc.)

To keep the event running smoothly, all competitors will be expected to keep track of the running order and to be in the 'on deck' area prior to your run.

★ IMPORTANT NOTES ★

The safety of all handlers and dogs is our primary concern. All exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with and will abide by the **CARO Rules & Regulations** and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. (*Note: Please be aware that there are rule changes/updates affecting Signs #'s 42 & 43, coming into effect as of September 1st, 2014.)*

Anyone observed disciplining their dog in a manner that offends a judge's sensibilities will be excused and will forfeit entry fees.

**ALL DOGS ENTERED <u>MUST</u> BE REGISTERED WITH CARO IN ORDER TO COMPETE. Dog registration is a one-time procedure to obtain a CARO registration number. If you are new to CARO and your dog is not yet registered, you have 3 options to be eligible to compete in this trial:

Option A: Go on-line to the CARO website at http://www.canadianrallyo.ca/page/registerdog You can register your dog online and pay a one-time registration fee via PayPal.

Option B: Download a PDF Version of the Dog Registration form (on the above mentioned link), complete it and mail it with your payment directly to CARO (fees and mailing address are on the form).

Option C: Download the Dog Registration form (on the above mentioned link), complete it, and prepare a <u>SEPARATE CHEQUE made payable to CARO for the applicable registration fees</u> (shown on the form); and include both with your entry for this trial. It will be submitted to CARO with the trial results at the conclusion of the trial.

Note: For Options A & B, you will need to do this well in advance, so that you have received your Registration Number by the time of the trial.

AWARDS

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog/handler team achieving a score of 170 or better. Rosettes will be awarded to all dog/handler teams who complete a New CARO Title.

CRATING & EXERCISING

All dogs must be crated, in an ex-pen, or on leash when not in the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds.

We ask that all dogs be exercised only in the designated "Potty Zone" (signed and marked) on the grassy boulevard on the corner of St. Joseph and Dumoulin. *Please* do not allow your dog to potty or mark anywhere other than in the designated area; we will have plastic bags and a receptacle available for clean-up. ANYONE OBSERVED NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOG WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

TRIAL VENUE

Winnipeg K9 Education Centre is an indoor training facility in Winnipeg. Limited space for crating indoors is available and there are washrooms and water onsite. Bring your own lunch or take advantage of numerous restaurants within a 5-10 minute drive.
