Entries will be run in the order they are received and accepted; alternating male and female and splitting dogs being run by the same person where possible. No dogs will be allowed to run after completion of the first test.

WORKING CERTIFICATE TEST - The Working Certificate Test shall be for all retrievers and standard poodles over six months of age on the day of the test, who have not won the title of W.C. The Tests for WC shall be:(1) back to back singles on land, (2) back to back singles on water.

WORKING TEST INTERMEDIATE - The Working Certificate Intermediate Test shall be for all retrievers and standard poodles who have earned a WC title. The Tests for WCI shall be: (1) land double, (2) honour on the land test, (3) water double

WORKING TEST EXCELLENT - The Working Certificate Excellent Test shall be for all retrievers and standard poodles who have earned a WCI title. The tests for WCX shall be: (1) walk-up test with a land double or a land/water double, (2) honour on the walk-up, (3) water double, (4) land blind, (5) water blind


ENTRY INFORMATION

No post dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards . All fees must be paid before the show.

Entries must be submitted by mail, hand delivered or via the Entry Line. No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events

A copy of the Rules pertaining to & WC Tests is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

Rule 14.7:

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

Release and Indemnification of Landowners:

By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the trial and

agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or his heirs, his executors and assigns.

NOTE


CKC Non-member Participation Fee a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

"This only applies to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member."

If a dog is foreign born and owned, it obtains an Event Registration Number (ERN) or CKC registration number from the CKC within 30 days of the first test entered. Failure to do so within 30 days will result in the cancellation of all passes earned.

AWARDS:CKC rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs.
