Pre Novice This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-

Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. A dog that has earned the title of C.D. is not eligible for this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement

to advance to the Novice Classes.

Novice AThis is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D.

(Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to

handle a dog in this class.

Novice B This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D.

(Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No

dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

Novice C This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X.,

U.D., or any Óbedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C

Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.

Novice Intermediate This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X.,

U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship. <u>Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial</u>. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class is an

elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes.

Open AThis is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not

earned the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may

not handle a dog in this class.

Open B This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. in Canada.

Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility Class are also eligible for entry in

this class.

Utility AThis is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has

not earned the title of U.D.. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H title may not

handle dogs in this class. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class.

Utility B This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D.

Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B at the same

trial.

Unofficial Obedience Classes

<u>Veterans Class</u> for any purebred dog that has an obedience title and is 7 years of age or older on the day of the

trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. <u>Dogs entered in this</u>

Class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

<u>Brace</u> Two dogs which have earned at least a Canadian CD title. The exercises shall be performed

and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in this Class must also be entered in any

Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.
