MR RAY GOLDSTONE

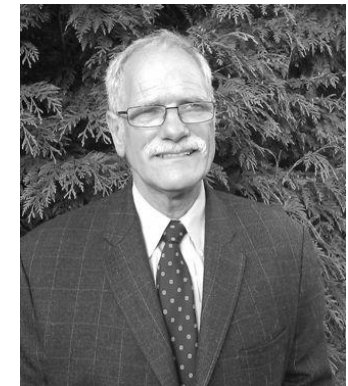

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **6 months of age and under 9 months of age** on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - this class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada (*Champions of any country excluded*)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERANS CLASS: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will **NOT** compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best in Specialty Show competition. **SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS.**

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog **MAY** be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary **ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED.** Listing Fees **WILL NOT** be refunded.

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades **ONLY.**

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Note: Any dog entered in an Unofficial/Non-Regular class **MUST** also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

SIRE & GET: shall be for Sire and three maximum of his Get.

BROOD MATRON & PROGENY: Shall be for Dam and three maximum of her Progeny.

BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), identical ownership is **NO LONGER** required

TEAM CLASS: Shall be for four dogs (not necessarily the same sex), identical ownership is **NO LONGER** required.

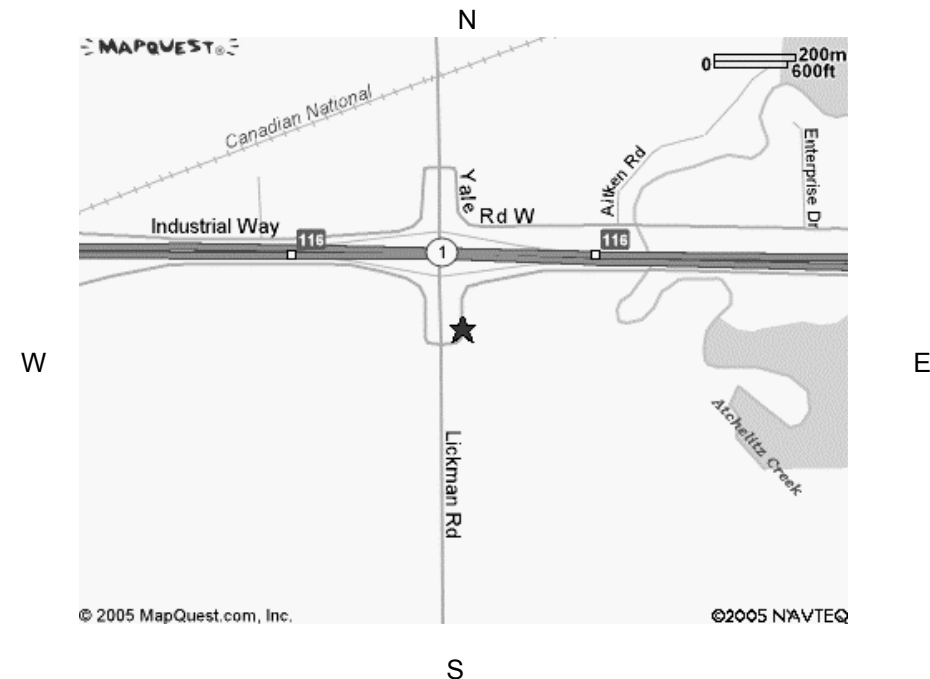
Heritage Park @ Lickman Road

East from Vancouver, Hwy 1 take exit 116 (Lickman Road)

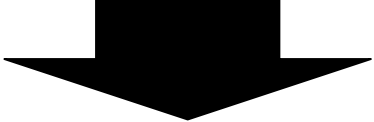
West from Hope/Interior/Alberta, Hwy 1 take exit 116 (Lickman Road)

Reserved grooming - again, offered at NO CHARGE! Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Individuals, or groups of individuals with a minimum of 6 dogs may request space. This will be on a first come, first served basis. If you are coming with a large number of dogs, PLEASE request grooming in advance, rather than expecting to be accommodated at the last minute!!

Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first serve and all equipment **MUST BE REMOVED** after Best in Show each night. There will be **NO** exercise pens allowed in this area. Any equipment left in DAY OF SHOW grooming after Best in Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates. Please note: Exercise pens in all areas except Day of Show Grooming (no pens permitted in this area) **may** be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

Specialty clubs will be given a 10' x 15' UPON request. This can be increased depending on the breed and number of entries. Please make your request as soon as possible.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted, may be asked to leave the show.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Renaissance Dog Association, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
