Entry and payment must be received before closing to be considered a valid entry.

Starting dogs in the major stakes to be determined by the TSX closing on Wednesday, Sept 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024. A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the all-age stakes. A system of rotation may be used in the minor stakes.

- Entries will be accepted until the draw date and time, please send one entry per dog running the trial. Make all fees payable to the FVRTC in Canadian funds only.
- A temporary competition fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Shows & Trials division toll free at 1-855-364-7252. A TCN fee of \$10.50 must be included with your entry for the trial. CKC registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial, or all wins and awards will be cancelled.
- Refunds must be requested in writing and must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.
- Please note CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non- CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.
- Catalogues will be available on CanuckDogs.com (paper catalogues won't be available on site).
- Dead ducks and/or pheasants will be used in this trial.
- Males and females will be run in order of the draw.
- Wingers may be used in all stakes.
- Female dogs will not be vetted, and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial.
- Eliminated dogs may be allowed to run out of contention in the minor stakes as time allows.
- Junior & Qualifying stakes will be combined, no double staking.

### Retriever Field Trial Rules & Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club State In:

#### Section 21.7, Page 73

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to any indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

#### Section 3.3.2, Page 8

"Judges shall have the authority to disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried."
