Info:

- LIMITS of 60 dogs for each Sprinter Test;
- Dogs will complete both runs for the day (Test 1 & Test 2) in the same Block of Time, as shown in Table 2;
- You will receive your assigned Block Time few days before the events, after the entries are closed;
- Lure Coursing (LC) Equipment will be a gas-powered machine (BoBinator) or electrical batterysupported equipment (inJoy One). Both type of LC apparatus will be set up as continus loop and a white plastic bag (s) will be used as a lure.
- Electronic Timer (Farmtek) will be used.

HOW THE EVENT IS RUN

ELIGIBILITY:

Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that are:

- a. Individually registered with CKC;
- b. Have a Event Registration Number (ERN);
- c. Have Performance Event Number (PEN)
- d. Eligible for registration to a CKC, lor
- e. Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed;
- f. Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed (dog must be spayed/neutered).

BEFORE the EVENT:

You are responsible for:

- 1. Reading the Sprinter Rulebook and be familiar with rules pertaining to event in which your dog is competing;
- 2. Sprinter requires you to have someone catch/leash your dog at the end of the 100meter dash. Please arrange your Catcher and Releaser prior to the Tests;
- 3. Completing the club waiver (attached);
- 4. Your helper, must also complete the club waiver;
- 5. Completing the Competitor Record Sheet (emailed prior to even)t;
- 6. Emailed both forms BEFORE the test (s): <u>norfolkcountyhoundclub@gmail.com</u>;
- 7. Calculating/checking your own dog points and knowing if your dog has achieved any titles. Your dog's Sprinter points are available on your CKC portal;
- 8. Packing two (2) leashes and one flat collar with no tags.

DAY of the EVENT

- 1. When you arrive, go to the hospitality <u>tent to check-in</u> with the event secretaries. The tent is located to the South side of the venue (back of the field);
 - a. Dog Inspection: the owner will be asked to move the dog, up & back (about 10 meters up and 10 meters back), on a straight line at a trotting pace (similar to a conformation show). The dog will be then checked for any lameness;
 - b. Bitch Inspection: the owner will need to swab your bitch with a tissue for in season check. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter these tests;

- c. If you dog has not been measured at a previous event, he/she will also be measured;
- d. Competition Record Sheet marked by the event secretaries as present.

2. The running order will be posted on a white board by the tent. Follow the instructions provided by the Paddock Master.

- a. Catchers should be already at the Finish Line with a leash in their hand. (Bring a chair if needed);
- b. Two dogs before your run, the releaser + dog proceed to the line up in the designated waiting area adjacent tot he Starting Line;
- c. Listen the instructions for the Hunt Master and the Lure Operator who ensure the safety of the run;
- d. Once your dog runs and is caught and leashed, the Catcher will write down the dog's time from the scribe. The Catcher will clear the Finish Line area to walk back the dog to the Releaser.
- e. As illustrated in Table 2, the run-in order is cycle TWICE.
- f. Once you have completed your Test 1 and Test 2, collecte your ribbons at the Secretaries' tent. Note. If you wish to taken your ribbons back home, you can leave them in a box 'returned ribbon' at the desk. Thanks.

AWARDS AND PRIZES:

Qualifiers will receive flat ribbons. Rosette will be provided (without extra charges) for dogs achieving a title during these events.

1. To hold the Host Club including its members, directors, officers, employees and volunteers (collectively defined as "the Host Club"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

2. To hold the Host Club harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Host Club or any other person(s);

3.
