CKC Competitor Information



Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in this event a dog must be 12 months of age or older and have a CKC Registration number, CCN, MRN, MCN, PEN or a TCN. Bitches in Season are not allowed to compete and will be refunded their entry and listing fees provided a veterinarian's note stating that the female was in season within 10 days before the start of the trial and is submitted to the Event Secretary on or before the day of the event

Listed Dogs

Dogs without an individual CKC registration number must obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). The TCN allows a dog that is eligible for CKC registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN), to participate in CKC events. Temporary Competition Numbers must be obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid.

While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees when entering events.

Non-Member Participation Fee

An annual non-member participation fee will apply to any exhibitor who is a Canadian resident and a non-member of the CKC earning awards/titles. To protect awards/titles earned the non-member will have to pay \$64.00 for each dog being tracked by the CKC or become a CKC member within 30 days or notification. Failure to comply will result in loss of awards/titles.

Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Discounted cheques will not be accepted. Cheques in US funds are accepted for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". Bank drafts and money orders in Canadian funds are recommended.

Event Information

- **Sprinter Event rules:** can be found at [Sprinter-Rules-and-Regulations-Effective-January-1 \(ckc.ca\)](https://www.ckc.ca/Sprinter-Rules-and-Regulations-Effective-January-1)
- **Running order:** Competitors will be put into heats of up to 20 dogs and each handler will have their three runs during that heat. (subject to change) All dogs will run individually and will have a maximum time of 60 seconds for their run. Competitors must have a 2nd handler present to release or catch the dog. If you don't have a second handler for releasing purposes, we can provide one for you. Each handler must have closed toed shoes for safety reasons. Each person must be listed on the entry form, sign a waiver and both must have a leash. Catcher must proceed to finish line in a timely manner. Once the heat is done, you will need to leave the premises to allow for the next heat to compete.
- Flat **ribbons** will be awarded to each dog that earns a qualifying time. New title rosettes will be available.
- **Equipment:** continuous loop lure with plastic bags and electronic timing will be used

Event Information cont'd

- **Collars etc.:** dogs may wear a flat buckle collar without tags or tags can be taped up. Owners may also have their dog wear a muzzle if they desire. Rubber bands can be used to hold the dog's hair out of the eyes if they wish. Owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog regarding the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.
- **Earning Points:** The dog's time to complete the 100-meter dash is converted into KPHs. The formula to complete this calculation is 360 divided by the dog's time over 100 meters. This calculation should be rounded to two decimal places. A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers: (a) 18" or greater = handicap is 1.25. (b) 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5. (c) Below 12" = handicap is 2.0. Points = KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example, 20 KPH x 1.5 = 30 points. Round off points to the nearest whole number. A sheet to keep track of your results will be sent with the judging schedule.
- **Titles:** are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: Novice Sprinter (NS) = 150 points; Sprinter (S) = 500 points; Advanced Sprinter (AS) = 1,000 points; Sprinter Excellent (SX) = 1,500 points; and SX followed by a number (e.g. SX2) for every additional 500 points.
- Please **proofread** your entry as you are responsible for errors
- **Fast food** is available off site within a few minutes from the venue. You are responsible for your own food.
- When on the **premises of Country Lane Pet Resort**, always drive slowly and cautiously. No more than 10 km/hr.
- Dog must be **always on leash** other than when they are running the course
- Please **pick up** after your dogs or risk excusal from the grounds
- **No provision** for inclement weather
- **NSF cheques** will be subject to a \$35 service charge
- **Schedule** will be emailed after the closing date
- The event will run more efficiently with the more **volunteers** we have. Family and friends are welcome to help. Liability waivers must be signed upon arrival. A sign-up sheet will be available at the event and volunteers can also sign up by sending an email to: drcadogs@gmail.com

Liability Agreement

Please read, sign, and return with entry form

I (we) acknowledge that the Durham Region Canine Athletes Club has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this sprinter trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, agents, superintendents, sponsors, event secretary and the owner of the premises (Country Lane Pet Resort) and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the sprinter trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the above- mentioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and for any claim of damage or injury to the dog whether such loss, disappearance, theft, death, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause(s).

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the above- mentioned parties harmless of any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this sprinter event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Covid Safety Waiver

I fully attest to the best of my knowledge, that I do not have COVID -19 and that I have NOT been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID- 19 within the past 14 days.
