Please ensure that you bring inside shoes, as no outdoor footwear is allowed on the blue matting!

<u>Check In</u>
Exhibitors must check in **ONCE** over the weekend.

Check in all 3 days is from 7:30 am onward.

Trial instructions and Judge's briefing will take place all 3 days at 8:15 am. Walk through is immediately following the judge's briefing. The first dog on the line immediately following walkthrough (approximately 8:30 am).

#### **Benching**

FREE on-site <u>limited</u> benching. Please be respectful of the space and only use what you need. Benching will be a mixture of either using the facility kennels or your own crate or benching from your vehicle. There are 10 Large, 4 medium and 24 small facility kennels available for exhibitor use in the training area. There is VERY limited benching within the Training area. If you are bringing in your own crate, they CAN NOT extend beyond the facility kennels into the walkway. Any dogs benched in the Training area must be well behaved and not be reactive to dogs walking past. Any dogs that are being disruptive in the training area kennels will be asked to bench out of your vehicle. There is a lot of close, free parking, so please be prepared to bench out of your vehicle if necessary.

Please be courteous to the other exhibitors and do not linger in the hallways close to the ring entrances and exits.

#### **Concession**

There will **NOT** be a concession at these trials. Please bring your own food and drink, or there are lots of options within a 10-minute drive from the venue.

#### **Parking**

There is plenty of Free Parking, the North Lot is the closest to the Training area.

#### Move Up's and Day of entries

We will be doing move ups BETWEEN each trial each day – so there are same day move ups allowed. We are taking Day of entries if we have not hit our 250/day run limit per judge.

#### **Important Rules**

Picking up after your dog and yourself is totally your responsibility. There will be waste containers available on site for dog droppings, regular waste and recycled waste. Please use them – there is zero tolerance for waste left behind.

The Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta and Good as Gold Training will not be responsible for the loss or injury to any dog, person or vehicle/belongings whether the result of an accident or other cause during the trial weekend.

#### Equipment

Obstacles: Agility obstacles meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules.

Note: A-Frame, Dog Walk, Teeter and Table have rubber surfaces, and the tire is a breakaway.

Wall Jump and Broad Jump will not be used on any course.

No equipment familiarization.

NO toys that make squeaky sounds will be permitted within 15 feet of the ring.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

#### **General Rules Governing these Trials.**

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Agility Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (<a href="https://www.ckc.ca">www.ckc.ca</a>)

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the agility trial. The Trial Chairperson shall have full control of the above trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Trial Chairperson for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial Chairperson shall promptly report to CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the trial grounds.
- 6. Only dogs entered in the trial are allowed within the show precincts. The show precincts are anywhere inside the Good as Gold Building.

No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, strikes, Federal, Provincial or Local requirements or any other cause beyond the control of the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta.

Any Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or etransfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian (except as written in this Premium List) or the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds will be MAILED to the exhibitor.
