No entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time, for entries, except for as provided in the rules. Same day entries will be accepted up to just before roll call.

** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

A non-member participation fee of \$62.40 plus HST will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized-breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC studbook it may be entered as a listed dog per CKC rules for this designation, as of July 1, 2018; exhibitors must apply to the CKC for "temporary competition number (TCN), before event closing date".

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$62.40, plus taxes.

Red Barn Event Centre Speed limit on the grounds is 10km/h; anyone not in compliance with this will be asked to leave with no refund of entry fees.

Outdoors on grass 100 metre straight-line plus start and finish areas Shade is not provided

Fencing is used along the 100m track
Equipment will be continuous loop lure with plastic bags
E-timing will be used


Please bring 2 leads and someone who can catch or release your dog

Inform the Trial Secretary with your entry if your dog is difficult to catch at the end. Notify the Gate Steward before your run and a catch chute will be used for all dogs that are difficult to catch at the end of their run.

<u>Directions to the Red Barn Event Centre, Barrie, ON:</u> GPS coordinates: lat 44.344860 long -79.741025

<u>From the 400:</u> Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27 (aka Town Line Road). Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From CR 27 South: Follow CR 27 northbound through Thornton. Continue north. After 5 minutes, look for signs on your right that show you have to turn LEFT to stay on CR 27. When you see that sign, turn left, continue on CR 27. When you come down the big hill look for our white flags on the west (left) side of the road. If you get to lights at Ardagh, you've gone too far.



VOLUNTEERS: They are essential to help run these events, so we can all enjoy our dogs having fun. Please consider volunteering at these events, learn to work as a starter, timer, begin learning about lure operating or helping other exhibitors with releasing or catching.

RIBBONS and TROPHIES:

- Flat, qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying times
- Prizes will be awarded for top qualifiers within each height category (under 12", 12"-18" and over 18").
- New title rosettes will be offered at a cost of \$8.00 per rosette

EARNING POINTS:

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into KPHs.

- A handicap system is applied based on the height of the dog at its withers
- Handicap: Under 12"= 2.0 12"-18"=1.5 Over 18"=1.0
- Points = KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap.

Sprinter Titles will be awarded for dogs that accumulate the required points. For purebred dogs, these are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.

- Novice Sprinter (NS) = 150 points
- Sprinter (S) =500 points
- Advanced Sprinter (AS) = 1,000 points

- Sprinter Excellent (SX) = 1,500 points
- SE followed by a number (e.g. SX2) for every additional 500 points

Liability Agreement

I (we) acknowledge that Simcoe Performance Dogs, dba Red Barn Event Centre and Performance Dogs Canada has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this agility trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

All fees are payable in Canadian Funds. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by correct fees. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

Tendering of NSF cheque is considered as non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$40.00 service charge.

The owner or handler of the dog must sign the Liability Agreement & mail it with their entry. **On-line entries must** bring a signed the liability agreement to the trial.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except as noted in this premium list. **The ONLY exception is bitches in season.**

Refunds

Anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date will receive a credit in the amount of 50% of their entry fees excluding the online entry service charge if applicable) towards a future SPD CKC event held within twelve (12) months of this trial.

Foreign Exhibitors

Personal US cheques will be accepted in US funds, but due to fluctuating currency rates they cannot be discounted. Please do not mark personal foreign cheques "Payable" in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Thank you.

***NEW** - Effective for all SPD trials held after November 12, 2018, exhibitors entering electronically (online or by email) for any entry will be charged 10% electronic entry fee. This fee applies to entries that are not mailed in hard copy with enclosed cheque payment in advance of the closing date.

General Information

The Event Chairs are in full charge of the event. The Lure Operator will inspect the track to ensure no harmful objects within five yards on either side of the lure path. The Starter has control of the track in terms of ensuring dogs are on the line and all positions are ready.

PLEASE STOOP TO SCOOP! Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave and may be prevented from attending future events.

Dogs may run with a flat buckle collar with no tags or attachments (no chokers or prong collars allowed); it is recommended to ensure collars are snug to prevent getting caught on anything during their run. Slip leads are recommended to bring the dog to the line and flexis and electronic training collars or not allowed on the grounds. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair and may use muzzles to prevent destruction of the lure. Owners assume the responsibility for the safety of their dog with regard to the collar or anything attached to the dog. Handlers are recommended to use a helper to catch their dog at finish or assist at the start line.

Dogs must be **ON LEASH** at all times except during their run. There will be a \$20 fine for any loose dog interfering with a course in progress.

All dogs will run individually and will have a maximum time of 60 seconds for their run.

Bitches in season

Females in season may not enter and are not allowed on the event grounds. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed, a Veterinarian's note certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the event must reach the secretary on or before the start of the event. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given. However, if e-transfer was used the 10% processing fee will not be refunded.

Eligibility

SPRINTER participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Performance Event Number (PEN) or eligible for the registration with the CKC or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed

Roll Call

Dogs not present at 9 am roll call will be scratched from morning trial and entry fees not refunded; NO EXCEPTIONS. Afternoon roll call time will be announced when morning trial finishes.

Females in season or lame dogs will be excused and their entry fees refunded provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. RUNNING ORDER IS POSTED AFTER ROLL CALL AT THE EVENT

Verification that your entries have been received will be emailed to you no later than six days before the event date. PLEASE contact us prior to the event date if you have not received an emailed confirmation from us
