#### ENTRY INFORMATION:

1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

**Attention USA exhibitors:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

#### NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

**Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members**

**Catalogues** catalogue's \$10.00 either pre-ordered or at the door.

Catalogues will not be mailed to absentee exhibitors.

**CONFORMATION CLASSES**

Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Veteran	Dogs who are 7 years or older
Altered	Dogs who have been sexually altered
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

**Champions and championship points - chapter 15**

**Section 1** - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder: **Section 2:**

Dogs competing *	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\* includes the dog awarded winners

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded winners also places in the group.

A class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. The Pictou County Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

2. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
3. The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
4. In no case may a dog under 4 months of age be allowed within the show/trial precincts.
5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
6. Only dogs entered in the Shows will be permitted on the grounds.
7. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
8. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and on the site.** Please make sure your x-pen area is clean before you leave.
9. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the PCKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
10. The Pictou County Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.

**All exhibitors are responsible for their dog's cleanup anywhere on the show site and area.**

**Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023** Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023**, the policy has been

**Event Registration Number (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian changed to allow Listed

Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension. **CKC HEALTH REMINDERS**

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;  
Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.
