DIRECTIONS

- From Toronto or From the East: Exit the HWY 401 westbound to the HWY 410 and go north. Take the extension that connects to HWY 10 north. Continue until you reach King St. Turn left. Stay on King St. into Terra Cotta. At the stop sign in Terra Cotta go straight through, staying on King St. After the bend in the road to the left you are now on Winston Churchill Blvd. You will cross the bridge over the Credit River and continue up the hill. Just past the top of hill you will see #12900 on your right. If you reach the 80 km speed limit sign you have passed our driveway.
- **From West:** Take HWY 401 east to Trafalgar Rd (exit #328 from 401) and go north about 6.5 km to the 10th Side Rd. Turn right and continue to Norval. Turn left onto Winston Churchill (also called Adamson St at this point) and keep going until you reach #12900, which is on your left.
- **From Niagara:** If you take the QEW east to Bronte Rd (HWY # 25 Milton), and travel north to Britannia Rd., turn right at the light. Continue to Trafalgar Rd and turn left (north). Once you pass over the HWY 401 follow the directions 'Coming from West'. **OR** take HWY 407 east to HWY 401 East exit and then exit the 401 at Winston Churchill Blvd. and travel north to #12900.
- **NOTE:** the house numbers on the left and right sides of Winston Churchill do not follow numeric order, so look at the numbers on the west side!

JUDGING ORDER:

The order of testing in a class shall be the order that entries are received, except when multiple entries of the same handler require separation when possible. Dogs will be run in height order, with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups. Dogs will be staged in groups of 5.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (continued)

HEIGHT CLASS:

Dogs are divided into groups by the height at their shoulder. Small 13" and under Medium 13.1" to 18" Large over 18"

TENTATIVE RUNNING ORDER BOTH DAYS:

Trial 1: Instinct begins at 9:00 AM, followed by Novice, Open, Senior, Master Trial 2: Master followed by Senior, Open and Novice

Judge will break for lunch at their own discretion.

Dogs are required to have a Barn Hunt Registration number to enter in Barn Hunt Trial.

Register your dog online at: www.barnhunt.com

Allow at least 24 hours to receive a Barn Hunt number.

Dogs may enter both the Instinct class and Novice class in the same trial until the dog has earned the RATN title and then they can't enter the Instinct class.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

VALIDATION OF ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, with entry fees, signed Participation Agreement included. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: will not be refunded after the closing date except for bitches in heat and for injured dogs with vet proof.

MOVE UPS: Dogs earning a title in Trial 1 may be moved up to the next class for the second trail. This is up to the handler and not required. Move-ups will be accepted up until 10 minutes after the conclusion of the relevant Trial 1 class. Move-up forms will be available at the secretary's table.

TRIAL SITE:

Trial will be held outdoors on grass with an outdoor staging/blind area Port-a-Potty will be on site.

Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs (E-z Up tent or X-pen).

This trial will be run rain or shine.

All dogs must be on a **short leash** and **under control** while on trial grounds except while showing.

Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness. It is strongly encouraged that the collar/harness be of a type that can be easily and quickly removed and replaced in the ring.

Wear appropriate footwear and clothing for the outdoors.

No flexi leashes are permitted anywhere on the property.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TRIAL RULES (continued)

AWARDS: Placement ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice, Open, Senior and Master classes in each height division.

Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and Instinct.

Dogs that earn a Barn Hunt title RATN or higher will receive a title rosette.

High in Class ribbons will be offered in Novice, Open, Senior and Master.

Any Border Terrier earning a qualifying score in Novice thru Master class will receive a custom-made luggage tag (complete with a stamped likeness of the breed) donated by Border Terrier Canada.

BITCHES IN SEASON: are eligible for entry, but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run in panties at the end of their class/test. Please inform the test secretary prior to the Trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing that you are bringing a bitch in heat. Owners of BIS should crate/confine their dogs away from traffic and other dogs, should post "dog in season" signs on their crate/in their area, and potty the dog away from other competitors.



What is Barn Hunt?

For hundreds of years itinerant 'rat catchers' travelled the countryside ridding barns and properties of vermin, thus helping to conserve food grains and prevent disease. The Barn Hunt Association has created a sanctioned sport based on this traditional dog work for all dogs, not just terriers. In this new sport, dogs locate rats (safely enclosed in aerated tubes) hidden in a straw/hay bale maze. It will test your dog's scenting ability, speed, agility and sure-footedness. Open to any and all dogs that can fit through an 18" wide by approx 20-22" high tunnel made of straw bales.
