- "High In Class" – will receive a Rosette and suitable Prize
- Ribbons will be provided for 2nd - 4th in each class and jump height
- Trophy for HQS to Member of Dumbbell Obedience Club(one each on Sat. and Sun.)
- Qualifying ribbons to be awarded for all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each agility trial
- A Qualifying score is 85 points or more out of a possible 100 points, with no non qualifying deductions except Excellent B where a perfect run is required.

NOTE: There is a NEW rule book dated January 2010. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Agility Rules and Regulations books are available from the CKC for a small fee.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Entry Payment: Please note that fees are due and payable in CANADIAN DOLLARS. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheque, "payable in Canadian Funds" or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Anyone wishing to withdraw an entry prior to the closing date MUST receive confirmation from the Trial Secretary that their withdrawal has been accepted.

This event is held under the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept, alter, cancel or substitute any entry reaching the event secretary after the official closing date and time for entries except for as provided in the CKC Rules

AGILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS: (Chapter 4 – Section 1.3t)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch comes into season after their entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, when a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial is submitted to the Trial Secretary.
2. Judging schedules, and entry confirmations will be sent by email or by the post office to exhibitors after the closing date.
3. Before each trial the judges will provide a course design which will be posted before judging begins.

THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THIS SHOW IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERRORS IN THE ENTERING OF THE DOG, REGARDLESS OF HOW, OR BY WHOM THE ENTRY WAS MADE.

The precincts of the trial are all areas reserved for the sole use of the Dumbbell Obedience club. Only Dogs **ENTERED** in the official classes are permitted within the precincts of the trial.

JUDGING SCHEDULE & CONFIRMATIONS OF CLASSES ENTERED

Will be emailed or mailed to all exhibitors after closing date. Please ensure you have an email address listed on your entries. Show catalogues will NOT be sent out.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Every dog entered in a CKC approved Agility Trial must be purebred and must be registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration #, a Performance Event Number #, Miscellaneous Certification # or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC miscellaneous Class Certification Number.

The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may NOT be lame or compete if it has tape or bandages. A dog can only be entered once in any one class at a trial.

CLASSES

There are 3 classes, Regular, Selected and Veterans
Each of these has a Standard class and Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) at the following levels:
Regular – Novice A and B, Intermediate, Excellent A and B
Selected – Novice, Intermediate, Excellent A and B

SELECTED CLASS INFORMATION: The Selected class will be the same as in the Regular class but will have adjusted height and course times will have 10% more time added. The owner may choose to enter the Selected Class in lieu of entering the Regular Class at any trial. The dog **must be entered only in Selected Class or Regular Classes at the same set of trials.** (A dog may move back and forth between the Selected Classes and the Regular Classes, but not at the same set of trials offered by a club on the same day or on consecutive days.)

NOTE: Regardless of the previous level your dog competed in, if they move to SELECTED they must enter into NOVICE.

VETERAN CLASS INFORMATION: At the option of the handler, a dog 7 years or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. The dog cannot revert back to Regular or Selected classes. The dog will retain titles and qualifying scores towards the titles accumulated. All veterans will compete as if running in the Selected class at one or two jump heights lower than regular with 10% additional time as allocated in the Selected class.

The Above Classes are divided by Height

Agility Novice A: For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or organization.

Agility Novice B: For agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Agility Intermediate: Is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Title or the Agility Master Excellent Title.

EVENTS OFFERED

Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves – For clarification of the requirements of these events refer to your CKC rule book

EQUIPMENT AND COURSE FAMILIARIZATION:

Contact familiarization will be available for Novice dogs only.

A warm-up area with a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the trials

ELECTRONIC TIMERS will be utilized for these trials

HEIGHT DIVISIONS – owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

10.1.1 The following jump height divisions shall be used in all trial classes:

- 8" – for dogs 10" and under at the withers
- 12" – for dogs over 10" up to and including 14"
- 16" – for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"
- 20" – for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"
- 24" – for dogs over 22" at the withers

10.1.2 The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Selected Classes:

- 4" – for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
- 8" – for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 12" – for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 16" – for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
- 20" – for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

8.4.5 Dogs entering the Selected Classes must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice Level. A dog may continue to compete at each level until a qualifying score at the next higher level is earned.

Selected and Veteran Course Times: 10% will be added to the standard times.

All courses have clearly designated start and finish lines with all obstacles, jumps clearly and sequentially numbered. The course layout for each class will be posted in an easily accessible area at least ½ hour before the start of the class.

SAME DAY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ALLOWED as per Rule 6.8.1

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number or a Performance Even Number (PEN) and has received 3 qualifying scores from at least 2 different judges, may be transferred to the next level provided that a written or electronic request is received not less than one hour prior to the commencement of each trial or in accordance with the conditions advertised in the premium list. **(See Event Secretary for official form.)**
