

**CONDUCT:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move-ups will be permitted between trials. A dog earning a title after the closing date may advance to a higher level providing the Trial Secretary is notified by AUGUST 8, 2011.

# PLEASE NOTE: Trial dates for 2012 - August 10, 11, 12

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and 10 feet surrounding.
- Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials
- The trials will be held outside on a grass surface. The courses will be set up within an enclosure of 110' by 110'
- No provisions have been made for rain or sun bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog.
- Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, then clean up.
- Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm-up area and on the course.
- No food or other device will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well-fitted plain buckle collar, quick release collar or no collar on the course (note: no tags or decorations are permitted on the collar).
- The competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release on the entry form must be signed.
- All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- The Thunder Bay Cocker Spaniel Club reserves the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.
- There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs.
- Electronic timing will not be used

### **Attention Foreign Exhibitors:**

The current rate of exchange favours neither the American nor the Canadian dollar. US currency will be treated at par with Canadian currency. Personal cheques or cash will be accepted at par. You may also purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in CANADIAN FUNDS or charge your fees to a MC or VISA account. MC and VISA charges will be processed in Canadian dollars with an additional 10% added to the total cost for this service. Please do not send personal cheques marked "Payable in Canadian Funds: or "At Par". Your cooperation is appreciated. THANK YOU.

### ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

As of January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles.

### **Event Registration Number (ERN)**

Foreign born dogs require an ERN to earn CKC titles. This ERN MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event WILL result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. To obtain an ERN, send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN. With the above, include a cheque, money order or MC/VISA number in the amount of \$57.75 Canadian payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. FAXED requests will be accepted.

#### Performance Event Number (PEN)

A PEN allows an unregisterable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Events include obedience trials, tracking tests, herding trials, draft dog tests, agility, lure coursing, earthdog tests, hunt tests, working certificate tests and pointing field dog tests. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met: dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC, dog for some reason is not eligible for CKC registration, dog must be spayed or neutered, dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (not necessary for ILP dogs), dog cannot be on the CKC miscellaneous class list, and in the case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP number. A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a listed dog. Events may only be entered after PEN has been issued.

#### JUMP HEIGHTS:

- 8" for dogs 10" and under at the withers
- 12" for dogs over 10" up to and including 14" at the withers
- 16" for dogs over 14" up to and including 18" at the withers
- 20" for dogs over 18" up to and including 22" at the withers
- 24" for dogs over 22" at the withers

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.
