

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:

Effective January 1, 2012:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents

Notice to all Foreign Exhibitors from the Canadian Kennel Club

Event Registration Number (ERN)

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:-Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number.- Please indicate coat type and size, if applicable
Fee for an Event Registration Number with the CKC is \$55.85
Include your payment in the full amount in Canadian Funds.

Payment may be paid with VISA or MasterCard, personal or business cheques, or money order. For Non-members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non- residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates

An ERN must be obtained within thirty (30) days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension

Any ties in individual classes or for High in Trial will be determined by the judge of that trial in accordance with rule 8.9.4.

Eligibility: To be eligible to compete in an obedience trial, the dog must be registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, or have a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. The judge of an obedience trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Trial Secretary and a Veterinarian's certificate that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, the Trial giving club will refund entry, service charges and listing fees.

NOVICE 'A' & OPEN 'A' CLASSES

Entries cannot be accepted into the 'A' Classes for two dogs owned by the same person. One dog may be entered in the 'A' Class; the other dog must be entered in 'B' The exhibitor, or a member of his immediate family, must handle the dog in all exercises.

A dog which has earned its CD degree in the USA or BERMUDA is not eligible for Novice 'A' class. A dog which has earned its CDX in the USA or BERMUDA is not eligible in the Open 'A' Class. Such dogs must be entered in the 'B' Class

Refer to the CKC Rule book for clarification

LISTED DOGS

Listed dogs may not be entered in Open or Utility. There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog maybe entered as a LISTED DOG except that a dog which has obtained 3 qualifying scores at obedience trials held under CKC rules may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under the club's rules until the dog is registered individually or has obtained an ERN number with the CKC or until its owner has provided evidence satisfactory to the CKC that are eligible for registration in the club's records.

Obedience Rules & Regulations

Chapter 20.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Junior Handling Obedience Competition,

Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Trial Secretary .Any dog entered in the trial may be used with the owner's or agent's permission. The Junior Handler will wear the armband number assigned to the dog for the trial.

Junior Novice A for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 years of age who have not achieved 300 point in the same class competition.

Junior Novice B for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 years of age who have achieved 300 point in the same class competition

Intermediate A & B Classes:

Junior Open A for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 year of age who have not achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

Junior Open B for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 year of age who have achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

Senior Novice A for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have not achieved 300 point in the same class competition.

Senior Novice B for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have achieved 300 point in the same class competition

Senior Open A for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have not achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

Senior Open B for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.
