Entries will be accepted by mail only. Payment must be included with entry, but no cheques will be cashed until trial closing date. Confirmation of entries will be acknowledged by email within five business days of entry receipt.

Notes to US exhibitors. Fees are due in Canadian funds. American cheques must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded. Do not mark cheques “Payable in Canadian Funds” or “At Par,” as they will not be cleared by the banks. Bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds simplify the process.

Border Crossing Government regulations require that any dog brought into Canada must have a current Rabies Certificate dated at least 30 days prior to entry.

Females in season

When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian’s certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded.

Veteran's Class – is open to dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years and older. ***Dogs entered in this class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.***

Rules and regulations governing these trials

1. Dogs must be kept under control and on leash at all times within the building with the exception of the obedience ring. No dogs not entered in these trials will be allowed inside the Show Barn with the exception of Certified Assistance Dogs.
2. Collars other than those specified in Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations are not allowed within the ring.
3. Dumbbell Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of, accident or injury to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
4. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called. (Sec. 8.6.2) Any judging conflicts must be reported to the steward as early as possible. All efforts will be made to accommodate exhibitors, but judging will not be delayed to do so.
5. If, because of civil disturbance, Act of God, or other events beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is no refund of entry.
6. All children must be under the control of an accompanying adult.
7. The club is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
8. The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and its grounds. The Trial Chairman shall have full control of these shows and trials, which are governed by Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) rules.
9. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs, both inside and outside the trial building. Dogs are not permitted in the washrooms.
10. No professional handler or trainer, or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through to its UD title in Canada or elsewhere, shall be allowed to handle a dog in the "A" class. (Sec. 9.1.3 & 10.1.3)
11. The club reserves the right to refuse entries for any reason.
12. The precincts of this trial are the Show Barn itself.

Junior Novice A Open to handlers 7 years of age and up to and including 11 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have not earned 300 points in a Junior Obedience class.

Senior Novice A Open to handlers 12 years of age, up to but not including 18 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have not earned 300 points in a Junior Obedience class.

Junior Novice B Open to handlers 7 years of age, up to and including 11 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have earned 300 points

Senior Novice B Open to handlers 12 years of age, up to but not including 18 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have earned 300 points

Junior Open A Open to handlers 7 years of age, up to and including 11 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have not earned 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD title before it may compete in this class.

Senior Open A Open to handlers 12 years of age, up to but not including 18 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have not earned 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD title before it may compete in this class.

Junior Open B Open to handlers 7 years of age, up to and including 11 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have earned 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD title before it may compete in this class.

Senior Open B Open to handlers 12 years of age, up to but not including 18 years of age as of December 31, 2011 who have earned 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD title before it may compete in this class.
