ENTRIES and PAYMENT: All entries are accepted by Dogshow.ca

WAIT LIST: We will maintain a Wait List. ALL entries must be received before the closing. Entries can be added from the wait list. Limited number of day of entries will be available, waitlist entries will take precedence.

ENTRY FEES:

Instinct \$20

Novice, Open, Excellent and Master: Single Component (Container, Interior, or Exterior) per dog per component \$30

Any combination of three (3) components (same dog) \$80

If day of entry available per component \$40

A Ribbon will be awarded for each qualifying score per component at all levels .Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive ribbons. A New Title Rosette will be awarded to all dogs earning a Novice, Open, Excellent or Master Title, as well as to any dog earning a Container, Interior or Exterior Title.



DogShow.ca Refund Policy was updated on April 7, 2021 to reflect that their service fees are no longer refundable for any reason. All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via Dogshow.ca. No other entry service is authorized to accept entries for these events. All entry fees must be in the hands of our Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Trial Secretary after the closing time and date. All fees must be paid before the trial. A copy of the Rules pertaining to Scent Detection Trials effective January 1, 2024 is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

RULES:

A copy of the January 1, 2024, CKC Scent Detection Trial Rules & Regulations may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

REFUNDS: As per CKC rules No refunds will be issued for cancelling after the closing date. Any Refunds allowed during the registration time frame will only be issued after the trial date.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- We will not be offering resets at this Trial. Only one dog per handler per class will be allowed.
- There will not be a warm up area
- KOC respectfully reminds exhibitors that anyone discussing hides before the end of the Trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules.
- The Precincts of these Trials shall be the Kingston Parish Hall, adjoining buildings, and the parking lots. Only dogs entered in the Trials may be on the precincts.
- The only dog permitted in the test area is the dog being tested.
- Be prepared to crate from your vehicle. There will be no crating inside the building. There will be a designated parking area.
- Due to space limitations, there will be a limited designated spectator area at these events.
- All dogs must be under control on a leash except during the test and only if permitted by the judge. All persons must exercise care and control of any dog in their possession.
- Please give every dog and handler space.
- The KOC reserves the right to refuse an entry subject to CKC rules.
- Please advise if you are bringing a bitch in season. They must run last in their class and wear clean, properly fitted panties.
- No exhibition classes will be offered.
- Dogs may not be lame or have a known communicable disease.
- The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the events that will be governed by CKC rules.
- The Kennebecasis Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, however KOC will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their dogs.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the Trial-giving Club to see that a Judge, Club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- No overnight recreational parking will be provided.
- No food will be available at the venue there is a convenience store and Pizza Shack close by
- If it is impossible to open or to complete the event because of riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather or other acts beyond the control of the Kennebecasis Obedience Club, no refund of entry fees or service fees will be made.
