The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Please check your confirmations for accuracy.

#### Move Ups by end of day Saturday for Sunday's Trial

DAY OF ENTRY - Sunday only, if space allows, \$40 cash only per dog per component.

**General Information:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. **(See CKC Scent Detection Section 3.6)** 

**Eligibility to Compete:** To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN, eligible for registration with the CKC, or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed.

Dogs must not be lame or must not compete if tape or bandages may impair its working ability. Dogs with physical challenges are able to compete, if, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. (See CKC Scent Detection Section 6.4)

Mixed and unrecognized breeds will be accepted at this Trial. These dogs must have a CCN (Canine Companion Number, <a href="https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Exhibitors/Canine-Companion-Number-Application">https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Exhibitors/Canine-Companion-Number-Application</a>)

Dogs that are eligible for a CKC or ERN number but don't yet have one should have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). These can be obtained free of charge online from the CKC. **CKC Non-Member Participation Fee**: The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to <a href="www.ckc.ca">www.ckc.ca</a> under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Membership Participation Fee is paid in the calendar year (January -December) in which the dog achieved its title and /or titles.

**Bitches in Season:** Bitches in season are eligible to enter. They must be run at the end of the running order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties. Please advise the Event Secretary. (See CKC Scent Detection Rule 6.5)

**Important Participant Information:** There will be no indoor crating. Only one handler and one dog in the building at a time during the test. Masks are optional. For the Judge's Briefings, all participants are encouraged to follow social distancing protocol. Participants must adhere to all Province of BC Regulations in place at the time of the Trials, including not attending the event if they are sick, have any Covid-19 symptoms or have been in contact with any person with Covid-19. No concession on-site.

# Entries close AUGUST 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024 @ 6:00 pm or when the limit is reached, whichever occurs first.

**Venue Info:** Please be advised that there are stairs, carpeted with handrails, to enter and exit the testing area on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor inside the building. There is one step to enter and exit the curling club floor area. There could be use of pop-up tents as search areas. Exterior pavement. Interior flooring is concrete and carpet. Dogs can wear socks or boots if needed.

There is parking available and please park in the designated area. Allow our committee to help you with a place to park. No special area will be designated for reactive dogs. These trials will be run rain or shine, so be prepared. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the trial where off leash searches are permitted. Flexi leads will not be allowed on the trial site. Please, clean up after yourself and your dog. If you wish to dry camp on site, please contact the Event Secretary.

**Collars, Leashes, Harnesses:** The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds. **(See CKC Scent Detection 9.9.4)** 

**Penalties Issued by the Club:** Dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination. Contamination of the search area, at the discretion of the Judge may result in a non-qualifying score. Any dog that urinates or defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the class and will result in a non-qualifying score.

**CKC Scent Detection Rulebook & Regulations:** It is up to the individual handler to review the CKC Scent Detection Rulebook prior to the trial. **Reminder:** That anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors as both the speaker & the listener will be excused. Video use must be approved by Judge at Judge's briefing. Recording devices will be left with Judge and returned to owner once class is complete. Handlers will be charged for any damage done to equipment or facility by dogs (including urinated on items thus rendering them unusable. No second dogs will be permitted in the same class. There can be no training or non-official use of odour on trial grounds. Upon approval of the Judge's, warm up boxes will be provided.
