Pee Wee - 4 years or age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. Non-competitive

Junior Novice - 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday, who have not won 6 - 1st places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open - 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have won 6 - 1st places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Novice – 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday, who have not won 6 - 1st places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open - 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday, who have won 6 – 1st places in the same class with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open Level and feels they have enough experience to complete at this level.

Senior Novice - 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday, who have not won 6 - 1st places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open - 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday, who have won 6 - 1st places in the same class with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that they have enough experience to compete at this level.

NOTES

1. Dogs will be allowed to stay in the building overnight; however, they will be left at the owner's/handler's own risk. There will be no over-night security. Name and contact information must be on the top of a crate(s) if a dog(s) is left in the building. There will be a \$100.00 fine if a dog is found in distress or becomes loose after the closing of the building and the owner/handler cannot be reached.
2. As per CKC rules all dogs on the show premises MUST be listed in the show catalogue. Because we have limited benching space, please leave your extra dogs at home. Any person found with dogs in the show building that are NOT entered as exhibition only will be subject to a fee of \$30 per dog per day.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. According to the City of Balgonie bylaws, dogs are not allowed off lead within city limits. Please respect this bylaw.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs, both inside and outside of the show building. Dogs must be exercised in the designated areas only. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to eject from the show anyone who does not clean up after their dog.
6. There are bathing facilities available via a hose with water temperature controls.
7. The Wascana Dog Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either the dog, exhibitor or patron. The Wascana Dog Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
8. ****NOTE TIME!! The show building will be opened Thursday, at 3:30 PM (NO SOONER) to 11:00 PM for exhibitors to set up. **The Club volunteers ask that you please wait until 3:30 PM before coming into the building so that they all have the time to complete what they need to do. The building will be open from 6:30 AM to 10:30 PM Fri & Sat; opens at 6:30 AM Sunday.**
9. X-Pens allowed in reserved benching spots ONLY. Plastic must be used under wire pens and X-Pens.
10. Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g. loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators.

NON CKC MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE (Canadian Residents Only):

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC instituted a non-member participation fee for all Canadian residents who participate in CKC event but are not CKC members. To protect awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applied to dogs wholly owned by non-members, resident in Canada and does not apply to US exhibitors, nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded **Winners** at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded. **Winners** shall be as follows.

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded **Winners** also places in the **GROUP** as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show**. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

Best Puppy in Breed – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is **NOT** required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to the group**, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes with a **TCN**. The **TCN** fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded**.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS AND OBEDIENCE TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C
