To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

All entry fees must be in the hands of our Show Secretary prior to closing date

Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to **N.S. German Shepherd Dog Club**.

No post-dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$30.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par." They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

Competition for Altered Dogs will be offered for dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES: Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

- Breeders Class Stud Dog and two or more of his progeny or a brood bitch and two or more of her progeny. All dogs must be entered in one of the official classes but need not be owned by the same person. Trophy to go to the owner of the sire or dam.
- Kennel Class 3 or more related or non-related progeny bred by the same kennel
 - Long Coat Class All dogs who have a long coat.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C

A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)

No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show/Test/Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event that will be governed by CKC rules.

2. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the Closing Date.

3. The NSGSDC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.

4. REFUND POLICY: If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

5. All exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling.

6. The precincts of the show and trial will extend 10' beyond the rings.

7. A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)

8. No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

9. Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - * Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly
