Entries received after this date and time will be rejected. The draw will be at the home of Gloria DeVos on Saturday May 27, 2023 and be held in accordance with CKC rules, January 2020, per section 6.6.1 p. 17. For refunds after the draw please refer to p.16 section 6.3 of the rule book. The Long Point Retriever Training Club is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada. Dogs entered in All-Age stakes may qualify for the National Stakes.

NRCC Fee: Effective in 2018, the NRCC is taking a proactive role to ensure future funding for National events. The NRCC is asking member clubs to collect \$5.00 per dog competing in each All Age Stake held. Fees collected are submitted to the NRCC Treasurer. At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the Host Club for that year.

NOTE: New Non-member participation fee

a) Beginning in 2011, an annual non-member participation fee for awards (placings) and titles will be charged to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards (points) and titles to be cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. d) CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website under CKC Services and then Forms on-line

Entries:

Please complete one entry form per dog, per stake, per day in which you wish to enter your dog(s). The cheque should be made payable to The Long Point Retriever Training Club and dated no later than May 27, 2023. A listing fee of \$ 11.30 (includes HST) must be submitted for any dog without an individual registration number or ERN. Alternatively, entries can be mailed. All monies must be received by the FT Secretary prior to competing.

Food:

A tailgate will be provided at Baypoint Kennels Saturday June 3rd.

Game:

Dead ducks and or pheasants will be used in all stakes.

Awards:

CKC rosettes and suitable prizes will be awarded to all dogs placing in each stake. CKC rosettes will also be awarded to dogs that earn a Certificate of Merit.

Note:

• A system of rotation will be used in the All-Age stakes. Starting number will be based on the two digits right of decimal on the prior Wednesday's TSX closing (June 1)

• A system of rotation is possible in the minor stakes as per the all age stakes. Marshals will announce any rotation at the trial.

• Judges shall have the power to disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tested

• Dogs are required to run in order of the draw (males and females alike) unless excused by the marshal for that stake

• Females in season may not compete. Refund of entry fee for any other reason will require a veterinary certificate

• CKC rules prohibit training on the grounds designated for the holding of a licensed trial. Private property is used for the trial, and permission was obtained for Club use on this weekend only. Please treat all property as if it was your own.

Excerpt from CKC Retriever Field Trial Rules and Regulations Chapter 21, Sect 21.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
