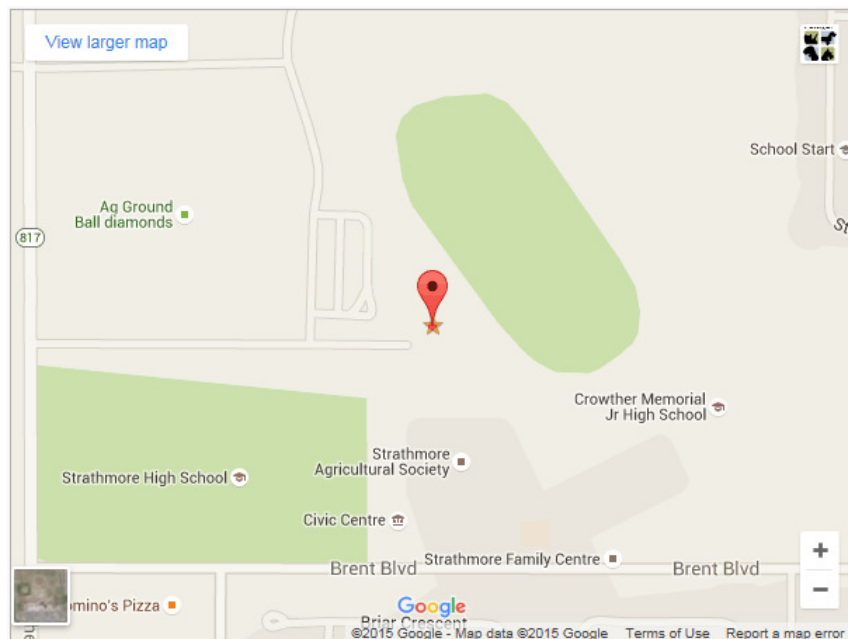

Entries open on April 15, 2016. Pre-entries will be accepted in the order received until the limits are reached or until **May 27, 2016 at 9:00 pm MDT.**

Day of trial entries will be accepted between 7:00 am – 7:45 am each day. Entries must be made in person, no emails or IM will be acknowledged. Maximum of 10 dog entries per envelope

Classes Offered Each Trial: RATI, RATN, RATO, RATS, RATM

Entry Limit: 100 Runs per Trial or 8 Hours of Judging per Judge

Trial is indoors. There will be limited indoor crating for entered dogs. **Dogs that bark incessantly must be crated in the handler's vehicle**

Schedule and Running Order

The building will open at 7:00 am and will close 1 hour after the end of the trials.

8:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. – Check-in and measuring
8:45 a.m. – Judge's briefing
9:00 a.m. – First dog on the line. (Instinct)

Running order: PEAA reserves the right to change the run order based on entries and will send final class run order and judging schedule confirmation prior to the start of the trial. Dogs will be run in height order. Dogs being handled by the same person must be separated into different staged groups.

Move-ups

Forms will be available at the Secretary's table. Previous trial move-ups must be submitted no later than 6:00 pm MDT June 6, 2016 via email or mail. Same day move-ups must be submitted no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the next trial. Next day move-ups must be submitted by end of trials on Saturday.

Class Descriptions

RATI (Rat Instinct Class): Three PVC tubes placed in plain sight on the course. Tubes will be: one dry, one with litter only (no gerbil), and one with both litter and a gerbil. Time Limit: 1 minute.

RATN (Novice Barn Hunt): Three PVC tubes hidden on the course. Tubes will be: one dry, one with litter only, and one with both litter and a gerbil. Time Limit: 2 minutes.

RATO (Open Barn Hunt): Five PVC tubes hidden on the course. Tubes will be: one dry, two with litter only, and two with both litter and a gerbil. Time Limit: 2 minutes 30 seconds.

RATS (Senior Barn Hunt): Eight PVC tubes hidden on the course. Tubes will be: one dry, three with litter only, and four with both litter and a gerbil. Time Limit: 3 minutes 30 seconds.

RATM (Master Barn Hunt): Ten PVC tubes hidden on the course. One to five tubes will have both litter and a gerbil. All remaining tubes will have litter only. Time Limit: 4 minutes 30 seconds.

Instinct and Novice may be entered at the same trial. Instinct Test is optional. You do not need to pass Instinct to test in Novice. You may not enter Instinct Test if you have achieved the RATN title.

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in all classes, including Instinct. Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each height division for all classes except Instinct. New title ribbons and High in Class ribbons will also be awarded. A special rosette will be awarded to those who earn a RATCH*. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Club.

**If you anticipate earning a RATCH at our trial, please let us know so that we have your special prize available.*

Exhibitor Information

It is expressly understood that participants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. Any participant whose dogs create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Performance and Earthdog Association of Alberta ("PEAA") and all persons associated with running this event will assume no responsibilities for any loss damage or injury sustained by participants or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property.

- **Barn Hunt Registration Number and Barn Hunt Rules and Regulations may be obtained on the website, www.barnhunt.com.**
- **Entries made without fees or signature and a completed Waiver and Indemnity Form will not be accepted.**
- If you provide your email address, we will acknowledge receipt of your entry via email within a few days. If you do not receive an initial confirmation within one week of submitting your entry, contact the Trial Secretary. Any errors must be reported prior to the commencement of the trial. If you do not have email but want us to confirm receipt of your entry, please include a SASE with your entry. A \$35.00 service charge will be added for any returned cheques.
- Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee(s) will not be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Abuse of any kind towards volunteers or trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the event.
- Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a 75% refund of entry fees paid upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the trial on Sunday afternoon. Priority mail is not necessary. If you have questions, contact the Trial Secretary directly at peasecretary@gmail.com.
- All dogs must be on a short leash (6') and under control at all times, while on trial grounds, except when in the ring for judging. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dog **must** run "naked," without a collar/harness. *The actual course area will be securely enclosed.* **No flexi-leads or head halters allowed within the show building.** Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site – this includes electronic bark collars. Prong collars may be used on the site while walking dogs, but are not allowed while the dog is competing.
- Bitches in season may compete. They will run at the end of each class. They **must** wear "pants" at all times when not being pottied, **including on the course. Owners of bitches in season should confine their dog(s) away from the trial area and other dogs, post "dog in season" signs in their area, and potty their dogs away from other competitors.** Owners should make their condition known to the Trial Secretary **prior to the start of the trials** and inform all exhibitors **at the judge's briefing.**
- The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class because the exhibitor is not ready. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready for their runs. **The club has no obligation or responsibility for calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.**
- There will be a short lunch break at the judge's discretion. Homemade breakfast and lunch items, snacks and drinks will be available for purchase.
- **BHA rules and common courtesy:** Exhibitors are responsible to clean up after their dogs. Dispose of waste in appropriate containers provided around the building.
- Possessing or training with personal, live quarry is not permitted on trial grounds at any time. Food and toys are **not** permitted in the ring. Squeaky toys are **not** permitted in the building.
- Show courtesy to all competitors. Manage loud or disruptive dogs. Treat every dog as if they were reactive or spatially challenged and remain aware of what your dog is doing at all times. Every dog and exhibitor deserves to have a pleasant experience.
- You **MUST** park where directed by our parking attendant.
- These trials are held indoors in a heated facility. There will be limited crating space for entered dogs only. No ex-pens allowed in the building. Please observe marked crating locations. Mats are required under crates.
- **There is NO SMOKING in this facility or on the grounds.** If you must smoke, please do so **inside your vehicle** and dispose of the butts in the vehicle. Anyone found smoking around the facility will be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
