While your vehicle is in use, an alternate crating area will be made available.*

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

- Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, or have a Temporary Listing (TL) number in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
- 2. Dogs must be 6 months of age on the day of the event.
- 3. An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

4. Temporary Listings (TL) are not available at the event. Please contact UKC directly prior to the event for a TL.

ENTRIES

- Pre-Entries: Licensed Classes: \$25.00 per entry, KSH members: \$22.00 per entry. CASH, E-TRANSFER or CHEQUE ONLY. <u>Entries must be received by event staff before May 20th, 2022.</u> Entries received after this date will be charged Day of Show Price – NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2. **Day of show entries (DOS):** \$28.00 per entry, KSH members \$25.00. CASH or CHEQUE ONLY.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

- Entries must be submitted on the current Official UKC Nosework Entry Form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of these forms may be used as well. Please be aware that the entry form has changed, please do not use an old version – you will be asked to resubmit your entry on the correct form.
- 2. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- 3. Pre-entries may be mailed, scanned and emailed, or hand-delivered to the Event Secretary.
- 4. **Mailed Entries** must include the entire form and be signed. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.

- 3. Returned cheques do not constitute valid entry fees.

REFUNDS

- 1. Entry fees will be refunded up to the day before the trial begins provided that a written request is made to the Trial Secretary. Should the event be cancelled, entry fees will be refunded.
- 2. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
- 3. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- 4. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- 5. If, in the opinion of the host club, the wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

Site Information: There will not be indoor crating space available. Dogs must be crated in vehicles. Owners are expected to pick up after their dogs.

Food will not be available on site, restaurants and grocery stores are within a 5 min drive on the Saturday, and a 20 min drive on the Sunday.

Driving Directions: From Castlegar, stay on Columbia Ave and head north, you will cross the Castlegar-Robson Bridge, stay on Robson Access Road, keep right and merge onto highway 3A (towards Nelson). Continue on Highway 3A for 12 km. Turn right onto Glade Ferry Road. Continue straight on Glade Ferry Road until the ferry. The ferry is free and on-demand. Once you are over the ferry, turn left onto Glade Road, continue on Glade Road for 550m, turn right onto Moraine Road. Continue on Moraine Road for 500m. Turn left onto Upper Glade Road. Continue on Upper Glade Road for 400m. Glade Acres will be on your right.

Hotel Information: Several pet friendly hotels/motels are located within Castlegar, as well as within Nelson. Castlegar options include the SureStay Hotel, Canada's Best Choice, Sandman Hotel, Super 8 Hotel, Cozy Pines Motel, and Twin Rivers Motel.

In Nelson, pet-friendly options include the Mountain Hound Inn, Alpine Inn and Suites, Best Western, and the Hume Hotel.

Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or drugs are allowed. Due to space limitations, only dogs entered will be allowed on the show grounds.

Awards to be Presented:

Kootenay Scent Hounds will award a qualifying ribbon for each element leg earned, ribbons for placements from 1st to 4th, and rosettes for Nosework Element titles and Nosework titles completed.

Move-Up Policy:

Participants may move up to the next level provided that the level is offered at this event. A completed Class Change form must accompany the request and the request is to be made while DOS entries are being accepted.
