Late/Day-Of Entries (if there is room): \$30/entry, no discounts. CKC Listing Fee for each entry without a CKC number, per event: \$10.50

*Note that there are TWO CLASSES to choose from when entering:

300 YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs (e.g. pugs, boxers, etc.) regardless of height.
600 YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. If there is a question as to which course a dog will run the judge will decide.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds or pay online via <u>DogShow.ca</u>

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee: The CKC has a tracking fee for nonmembers. Important Notes:

This is a PRIVATE residence and we are grateful for the use of this location. Parking, potty, and exercise areas will all be designated. Please respect instructions, pick up after your dog, and maintain control of your dog at all times. Flexi-leads are not allowed on the field. Field is entirely fenced hay field, gated entry to property, parking may be tight. Please bring everything you will need to keep your dog safe and comfortable for the weather (including food), there will be limited crating space so crating in vehicles is recommended if you can safely do so. There is a risk of injury for all active sports; you can reduce this risk by ensuring your dog is in athletic condition, only running your dog when you feel the field and weather are appropriate, and staying aware of your environment and any safety hazards. A \$10 fine, payable to WCOBC, will be levied for any dog loose on the field from the time of inspection until the completion of all events for the day. A \$10 fine, payable to WCOBC, will be levied for any dog loose on the field from the time of any exhibitor not picking up after their dog.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Chase Ability Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Tel: 1-800-250- 8040. **CKC Regulation:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Eligibility: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that are: (a) Individually registered with the CKC, (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN), (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN), (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

Border Crossing: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifiers will receive flat ribbons. Rosettes for dogs achieving a title during these events.

Directions to Site:

From Penticton or Kelowna (if you need directions from elsewhere, contact Aaryn Secker): Take BC BC-97 out of Penticton toward Osoyoos. Then 5.95 miles,9.58km from edge of Penticton/Skaha Lake Rd. Turn slight right onto White Lake Rd. (just past turnoff for highway junction to Vancouver). If you reach Old Kaleden Rd you've gone about 2.1 miles,3.38km too far.

Then 4.92 miles,7.92km. Turn left onto Fairview-White Lake Rd. Fairview-White Lake Rd is 0.4 miles,.06km past Observatory Access Rd. If you reach Twin Lakes Rd you've gone about 3.6 miles, 5.79km too far.

Then 1.48 miles, 2.38km. Fairview-White Lake Rd. becomes Willowbrook Rd. Then 3.53 miles, 5.68km Turn left onto Jones Way. Jones Way is 0.4 miles, .06km past Green Lake Rd. If you reach Orofino Creek Rd you've gone about 0.2 miles, .3kmtoo far. Then 0.35 miles, .56km

351 Jones Way, Oliver, BC V0H 1T5 - JONES WAY is on the left.

If you reach Myers Rd you've gone about 0.1 miles, .16km too far Note: Google Maps GPS does not recognize this address. "351 Jones Way, Cawston" *may* work, or looking to see where Willowbrook Road and Jones Way intersect. Please give yourself lots of time to find the property.
