Each day is a separate show, and the above fees apply per day, per show. These fees include the CKC recording fees + GST

ATTENTION: ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN) – A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN off (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC by mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, score, or awards, there is not need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppies will be divided by age and sex as follows:

Baby Puppy (4-6 Months) – Junior Puppy (6-9 Months) – Senior Puppy (9-12 Months) Yearling (12-15 Months) – Yearling (15-18Months)

The Great Dane Club of Canada will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% will be awarded as follows:

1st in Class – 20% of class entry plus a Ribbon, 2nd in Class – 15% of class entry plus a Ribbon, 3rd in Class 10% of class entry plus a Ribbon, 4th in Class 5% of class entry plus Ribbon. Best Overall – 15% of All entries and Rosette, Best of Opposite – 10% of All entries and Rosette

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED

12.2.1 Regular official classes at a CKC conformation show shall be as described in (a) to (k) of this sec on. All classes must be divided by sex (except for Specials Only). Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs 9 months of age and under twelve (12) months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 MONTH - for dogs over 12 months of age but under 18 months of age.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs. (Divided by color – Fawn/Brindle, Black/Blue, Harlequin/Mantle/Merle)

VETERAN Dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. This class at a specialty MAY be divided by age. The winners of all of the Veteran's classes will come back into the ring to compete for Best of Breed. (Divided by age – 7 to 10 years and 10+ years)

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible

UNOFFICIAL/NON-REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED (with the exception of Baby Puppy all entries in these classes MUST be entered in a regular Class or as Exhibition Only) **BABY PUPPY** Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for this class are:

Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

BRACE At an all-breed or specialty show a club may, but is not required to, offer a Brace Class. This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

STUD DOG Stud dog and 2 or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Get **MUST** be entered in a Regular Class.

BROOD BITCH Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Progeny **MUST** be entered in a Regular Class

ALTERED: Eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points **MAY NOT** be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately a er Best of Breed of the regular classes. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first-place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

GENERATIONS: 3 (or more) consecutive Generations, can be dog or bitch.

TEAM: The requirements for this class are the same as those for the Brace class except that four (4) dogs shall be entered.

Obedience Classes offered: Pre-Novice, Novice A, B, C, Open A, B & Utility A, B classes, Novice Intermediate

Rally Classes offered: Novice A, B, Advanced A, B, Excellent A, B, Intermediate, Masters

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR UNOFFICAL COMPETITION - Exhibitor Eligibility 1. Exhibitors must declare their dog eligible for Bred By Exhibitor Competition at the me of entry using the check box on the entry form. 2. The handler must be a breeder of record listed in the catalogue. 3. Dogs must be handled by a listed breeder throughout the breed level competition for the Specialty show. This includes the class competition and subsequent competition in the breed ring. 4. The Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition for the Specialty show. This includes Winners Dog and Winners Bitch. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the Specialty show. Determining Best Bred By Exhibitor in Breed The selection of the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed is held immediately following Specialty judging of that breed in the same ring. The ring steward will excuse all exhibitors not eligible. The judge will then award Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed. Judging of the breed for the Specialty show may determine the dog that is awarded the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed. Guidelines: • If the Best of Breed winner of the Specialty show is eligible for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed it will also be awarded Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed. • If the Specialty show Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed and the Specialty show Best of Opposite Sex is eligible, the Specialty show Best of Opposite Sex to will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed. • If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex from the Specialty show is eligible for the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. • If one of the Selects from the Specialty show is eligible for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed, excuse all eligible champions and then choose Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners. • If the Specialty show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed. If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed competition, no award will be made

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
2. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitors passes will be e-mailed
4. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
5. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
6. SHOW PRECINCTS: Whitemud Equine Learning Centre Assoc., excluding the commercial booth space.
7. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
8. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be not in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

15.2.4 GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. a. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand championship. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. c. Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS) a. The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand

Championship Bronze. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG) a. The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GCh.Ex) 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Champion Silver title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

a. one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed National specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).

b. three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.

c. a CKC performance title from any CKC event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance Title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward it to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.
