There will be no overnight benching and no exercise pens allowed.


Only dogs entered in the Trials will be allowed in the building.

You are responsible for picking-up after your dog, and will be asked to leave the Trial if you do not.

Note to Exhibitors: The 2025 CKC Obedience Rules are in effect. Significant changes have been made to the Pre-Novice, Novice and Open classes. Pre-Novice and Novice Handlers will require a 1.8M (approx. 6ft.) leash for the group stay exercises. There is now only one stream of Open classes (A&B), which no longer include group stay exercises. Handlers are responsible for familiarizing themselves with the 2025 rules and any changes that affect them.
