ENTRIES CLOSE: MONDAY AUGUST 19, 2024 AT 6:00 PM

Scratches will be refunded in full for a bitch in season and dogs withdrawn because of an injury or illness. Other scratches may be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion less a \$10.00 fee.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN): Owners of unregistered CKC recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). Dogs not registered in Canada must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for a field trial. TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Shows & Trials division toll free at 1-855-364-7252. A TCN fee of \$10.50 must be included with your entry for the trial. CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial or all awards will be cancelled.

Draw to follow at Field Trial Secretary's residence. Running Order will be posted to CanuckDogs.com Thursday August 22, 2024. Starting Dog to be determined using the TSX closing method. Starting Dog number will be based on the two digits right of decimal of the TSX closing on Friday August 23, 2024. A system of rotation will be used in this stake.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS AND SPECTATORS

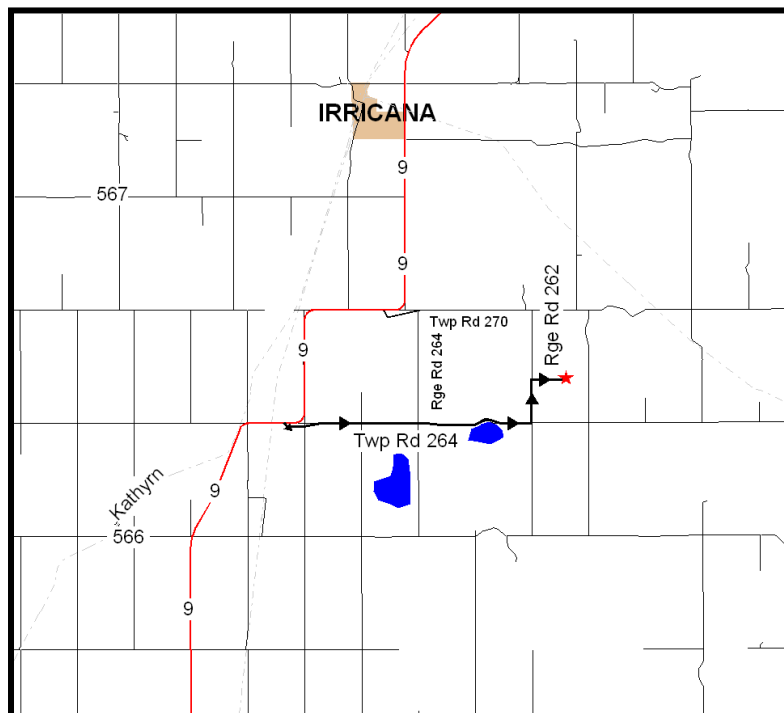
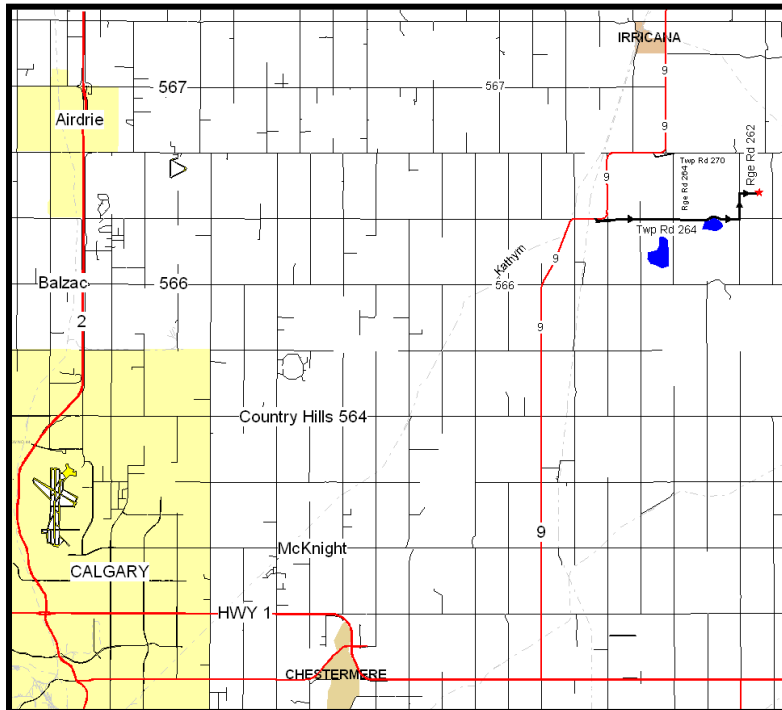
Release and Indemnification of Landowners and Alberta Field Trial Club: By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his heirs, executors and assigns.

RULE 21.7 of the Field Trial Rules States: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

RULE 4.1.6 of the Field Trial Rules States: "The trial secretary shall assume the responsibility of collecting all listing fees for the CKC, which shall be stated in the premium list."

Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot be awarded a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or membership fee to the CKC within 30 days.

Map and Directions to Trial Grounds At Bow River Retrievers (BRR) Training Grounds



Directions: From Hwy 9 turn south onto Twp Rd 264. The turnoff is to the south and the road immediately curves east. Travel east on Twp Rd 264 for 7 km to Rge Rd 262. Turn left (north). Travel 1 km then turn right (east) at 3rd laneway from corner. You will see a big house with red and wood siding (on right) and a large shop (on left). Continue to drive past this house. **DRIVE SLOWLY.** Travel 1 km straight ahead to blue bungalow (grey shed, large grey metal barn and log cabin).
