DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES: Day of trial entries will be allowed if space allows and must be submitted prior to judge's briefing. Day of entries will be \$40.00 per component and must be paid by **CASH ONLY.** Move ups are permitted and will be allowed for the next trial only and should be submitted before the end of the trial day! (Same day move ups are not allowed)

PLEASE NOTE: There will be no refunds for duplicate entries or overpayment of fees. It is the owner of the dog entered that is responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Please review email confirmations so corrections may be made prior to the closing date to avoid disappointment.

CKC REGULATION: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has OCCURRED.

Please note: You will be asked to remain in the parking lot unless being sent in to do an active search.

RUN ORDER: will be posted prior to the trial

CLASSES, TITLES & AWARDS:

Titles may be earned by class or by component. A dog may be entered in either the class or the component they are eligible for. Titles will be awarded once requirements are met for the class or component. For complete details: Scent Detection Rules and Regulations

COMPONENTS OFFERED:

Containers, Interior, Exterior

CLASSES OFFERED:

Saturday, May 3, 2025 – Instinct, Novice, Open, Excellent, Master Sunday, May 4, 2025 – Instinct, Novice, Open, Excellent, Master

RIBBONS/AWARDS: A Qualifying Ribbon will be offered for every qualifying score. "NEW TITLE" Rosettes will be offered for those qualifying in all 3 components in their class.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE: To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN, Eligible for registration with the CKC, or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed.

A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked. Dogs must not be lame or must not compete if tape or bandages may impair its working ability. Dogs with physical challenges are eligible to compete, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall be eligible to enter the test as of January 1, 2024. Should a bitch be competing while in season the handler must inform the club prior to the trial date. These entries will be scheduled to run last in each component and wear snugly fit panties.

IMMUNIZATION: The CKC Rules and Regulations for shows, trials and tests, with some exceptions, have explicit rules to minimise the transmission of communicable diseases. A dog may not be entered or exhibited at a show, trial or test if it has any communicable disease. Dogs entered in a show, trial or test must have proof of current immunisation status.

HANDLERS WITH MULTIPLE DOGS: Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than one dog in the same class / components. I.e.: Two Novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial.

TEST SITE: No indoor kennelling. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test (where off leash searches are permitted). **NO non-trial odour** is permitted on the trial grounds. No warm up area will be offered. Remember that this is a community facility. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event. We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. The trial facility is not

wheelchair accessible. Stairs are needed to access the building and maybe used during the trial to access some search areas. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs. Washroom facilities will be available indoors.

CKC REGULATION: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trialgiving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

ELIGIBILITY: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs

Every dog entered in an approved event or sanctioned match must be one of the following:

- 1. Registered with the CKC
- 2. Have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- 3. Have a Performance Event Number (PEN)
- 4. Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
- 5. Mixed breed Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

To be eligible to compete at approved trials or sanctioned matches a dog must meet the requirements of Section 6.1.1, and:

- 1. a) Must be at least 6 months of age.
- 2. b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked.
- 3. c) Must not be lame (it is the judge's responsibility to determine whether a dog is lame).
- 4. d) Must not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability (such a dog must be immediately excused and under no

circumstances may it be returned later for judging after the tape or bandages have been removed).

CKC SCENT DETECTION RULES & REGULATIONS:

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing.

INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA:

To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

PARTICIPANT ILLNESS:

Any handler unable to attend these trials due to exhibiting serious illness symptoms after entries close must contact the trial secretary so they may try to fill the available spaces. If those spaces are filled you will receive a refund, if spaces cannot be filled you will forfeit your entry.


WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time.
