These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test. A \$10 penalty will be levied if your dog is off leash and runs onto the course.

Dogs may wear a snug fitting "catch" collar as long as there is nothing on it that can become entangled in the line. Prong, Flexi-leads and Ecollars are *not* permitted.

# GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

**ELIGIBILITY:** Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that:

- (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed

**ENTRY LIMIT:** Entries will be limited to 30 runs per CAP test and 50/run for Sprinters. Post (day of) test entries *will be accepted* at this event at **\$30/test**. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test

**Inspection:** All dogs will be inspected for fitness prior to being allowed to run. Bitches will be checked to determine if they are in season. Entries deemed unfit or bitches in season will be issued a refund.

# WHAT IS THE CHASE ABILITY PROGRAM (CAP) TEST?

This exciting event, developed after the ever-popular Lure Coursing, allows dogs to uncover their natural prey drive through chasing a lure - all while having lots of fun. The Chase Ability Test also provides purebreds and mixed-breeds with the opportunity to compete and earn multiple titles and certificates in a field event that all dogs are capable of performing. Two types of courses will be available: one for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic dogs and another course for the remainder of the dogs entered. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. How does your Dog earn a Pass? A dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

#### **ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS**

Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it is a mixed breed.

The CAP is an athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in very good condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this.

Females in season may not compete.

If in the opinion of the Test Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete and the entry fees shall be refunded.

#### **TITLES**

There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program. They are:

#### Chase Ability (CA)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges

#### **Chase Ability Excellent (CAX)**

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of then times (CA + 7 additional passes)

#### **Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2)**

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)

#### **COURSE LENGTHS OFFERED**

**300 yards:** For dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic (flat-faced) dogs.

**600 yards:** For all dogs not eligible to run the short distance.

#### **AWARDS**

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a Pass grade.

A Rosette will be awarded to each dog that achieves a CKC CAP title.

#### **ATTENTION**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

# Temporary Competition Numbers: Self-serve Online Registration for Listed Dogs

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Until March 2, 2020 dogs may still be entered into CKC events without a registration number or ERN by marking "TCN" on the entry form (or "Listed" if it is an old entry form). However, an e-mail address will be required. Before you apply for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if CKC has already created a TCN for them. There will be a tab for TCN Dogs on the Owner's Portal account.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

#### WHAT IS THE SPRINTER EVENT?

The Sprinter event was launched by the Canadian Kennel Club on July 1, 2018. The Sprinter is a fun event open to all dogs to enjoy the challenge of running a 100 meter dash. All dogs entered will receive a handicap score based on their height, and their time to finish will be converted to kilometers per hour. Titles are awarded upon the dog accumulating a given number of points.

#### **ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS**

SPRINTER EVENT participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it is a mixed breed.

Sprinters are an athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in very good condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this.

Females in season may not compete.

If in the opinion of the Test Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete and the entry fees shall be refunded.

#### YOUR TEAM

CKC rules state that 'It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed.' VILCA would like to reinforce this recommendation. Please find a 'buddy catcher' to support your team.

#### **EARNING POINTS**

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater handicap is 1.25
- (b) 12" up to less than 18" handicap is 1.5
- (c) Below 12" handicap is 2.0

**Points** - KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example 20 KPH x 1.5 = 30 points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

#### **TITLES**

There are four titles dogs may earn doing the Sprinter event. They are:

#### **Novice Sprinter (NS)**

awarded to a dog that earns 150 points

#### Sprinter (S)

awarded to a dog that earns 500 points

#### **Advanced Sprinter (AS)**

awarded to a dog that earns 1000 points

#### Sprinter Excellent (SX)

awarded to a dog that earns 1500 points

#### **Sprinter Excellent 2 (SX2)**

awarded to a dog that earns 2000 points. For each additional 500 points the dog may add a higher number after the SX (SX3, SX4, etc.)

# **AWARDS**

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a score.

A Rosette will be awarded to each dog that achieves a CKC Sprinter title.
