

Specials Only dogs which are registered individually in the records of the CKC or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "Listed dog" in this class is NOT allowed, except for foreign born miniature dachshunds under one year of age.

Moving a Dog to Specials a dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with CKC rules, but at the time of entry closing has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from regular class to SPECIAL ONLY provided the transfer is submitted in writing to the Show/Trial secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR to the opening of the show.

Obedience Trial - the following official/unofficial classes will be provided for all breeds.

Novice A for any purebred dog that has not won the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only

one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner , co-owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its U.D. (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere, shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Novice B for any purebred dog that has not won the title C.D. (Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "sit" and "down" exercises. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for entry in this class.

Novice C for any purebred dog of either sex that has gained a title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility dog or any other advanced obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down exercises when they are judged in the same group.

Open A for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada, but that has not won the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its U.D. (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which as won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Open B for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "sit" and "down" exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has won the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs that have won the title of U.D. may enter this class. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility class is also eligible for entry in the Open B class at the same trial.

Utility for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D.X. in Canada. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "group examination" exercise.

Veterans the veterans' class is performed under the rules described for the novice class. Dogs must be 7 years of age or older PRIOR to the closing of entries. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may not be entered in any regular class. Dogs must also have a minimum CD tile

Pre-Novice – see CKC rule 13.2

CLASSIFICATION - RALLY

Rally Novice A – Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, coowner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Novice B – Any dog may complete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Rally Advanced A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

Rally Advanced B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent A – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families.

Rally Excellent B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided thereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly (entries excused or disqualified from the ring DO count), for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall be included in the calculation for championship points. In order for a dog be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges - with at least 1 (2 pt) win from the breed or group level: and (2) be individually registered in the recorder of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

General Information & Rules

- 1. CHAPTER 4.1.3, CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS A judge officiating at a show/trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show/trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show/trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out
- 2. CHAPTER 21.1 & 21.2, CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS "The participation in any manner or in any capacity at a competitive event held under these Rules shall be considered a privilege accorded to any person by the CKC and such privilege may be extended and withdrawn by the Discipline Committee." "Any person availing himself of the privilege of participating in any manner, shape or form
- 3. and in any capacity, including that of a spectator at a competitive event held under these rules shall, by such participation, be deemed to have agreed to the authority of the CKC and its Board."
- 4. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED (AFTER THE CLOSING DATE)** In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by act of the show/trial committee or because it has been entered incorrectly except as provided for in "4" below. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of Battle River Canine Association, it is impossible to open or complete the show, NO REFUND of entry fees will be made.
- 5. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON. Any female entered in the OBEDIENCE trials who, because of being in season, cannot compete will have the entry fee refunded. A VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 days preceding the trial) must be delivered to the Show/Trial Secretary PRIOR to the commencement of that trial's judging. This does not apply to the Championship show, as this condition is not a disqualification in conformation.
- 6. **Show Building** will be open for exhibitors on Thursday at 4:00pm Booth set up will begin at 1 PM. On the West End of building there is an overhead door. **NO** Vehicle will be allowed into the building. On the south side of the building are several doors that exhibitors can back their vehicles up to and off-load their equipment through.
- 7. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday the building will be open at 6:30 AM. The Building will be locked up by 11 PM on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evening.
- 8. Camrose Regional Exhibition will supply overnight security. They will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
- 9. The official veterinarian is "ON CALL". Anyone who wishes to have their service should approach the Show Superintendent who will arrange for the veterinarian's attendance. Please note that the person requesting the veterinarian's service will meet any charge for this service.
- 10. The **Show Superintendent** will be in full charge of the show/trial, which will be governed by CKC rules. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour prior to the scheduled judging of their breed. Dogs, which are not required for further judging, may be excused. Dogs must be ready for judging. The club and its superintendent will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class or group. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring.
- 11. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
- 12. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs. Dogs and children must be under control at all times. All dogs must be kept on a max 6' leash, unless competing in the Obedience Ring.
- 13. Entries will be acknowledged after the closing date judging schedule and receipt will be mailed.
- 14. **DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY**. Persons exercising dogs outside of the designated area who make no effort to clean up may be disqualified from that day's show/trial.
- 15. No dogs will be allowed on the show site unless entered in the show or trial or entered in exhibition only. Any dogs In Transit will be asked to prove age CKC registration certificate and must be registered with the Show Secretary Chapter 8.11.1 & 8.11.2 CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS
- 16. All entries must be typed or distinctly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. The Battle River Canine does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information on an entry form due to illegibility of information submitted by the owner or owner's agent or entering a dog in a class in which the dog in not eligible to enter.
- 17. Any ENTRY may be withdrawn PRIOR to the date and time of closing of entries by phone, provided that withdrawal of entry IN WRITING is received by the Show Secretary within 7 days after closing. Entries withdrawn by phone, but not confirmed in writing within the allowable time will be considered as valid and appear in the Show Catalogue, in which case, fees will not be refunded.

No signs stating dogs/puppies for sale will be allowed on show site. However communication with the public to promote your particular breed is encouraged
