Entries will be **limited** by the number of stock available one week prior to entry closing date. If necessary, first entries received will be first accepted. Same day entries will be accepted 1 hour prior to start of trial at a higher cost **if stock is available**.

There is also one limited entry trial for non-competitive (N/C) runs for each regular trial. Non-competitive runs will be limited to any dog that is stock handling or is being handled by a person who is judging or stock handling during the regular events. A dog may only enter the Non-Competitive trial if it is not entered in the regular (Competitive) trial.

In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$30.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Trial Secretary. Incomplete entries, entries received without fees and required waivers, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors!

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

Non-Member Participation Fee:

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charge to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: ERN numbers must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>

Section 18.1 of the CKC Herding Rules states: The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC.

Section 15.7 of the CKC Herding Rules states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club officer, ring steward volunteer or competitor at a herding trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trials Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

PLEASE NOTE: There have been many changes to the CKC Herding Rules that took effect July 1,2021. Rule books can be found on the CKC website.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!! Dogs must be on leash when not in the arena or the designated exercise area. There is livestock on the premises, so please control your dog, close gates behind you if you find them closed, and leave them open if you find them open. Thank you!

COVID REQUIREMENTS

Proceeding with this trial assumes that Alberta will be at a minimum of Stage 2 of COVID restrictions. Fees will be refunded if event is cancelled due to COVID (less expenses). Updates to Covid specific requirements will be provided in the Judging Schedule. A COVID Specific waiver will be available to sign prior to the Judge's Briefing.

Social distancing (3 sheep) will be in effect! Masks will be available. If you have been exposed to COVID-19 or are experiencing symptoms, please do not attend.

These trials are open to the public to spectate IF Covid restrictions allow. If you would like to come and watch, please leave your dog at **home**. Bring a lawn chair, mosquito spray, sun screen etc. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask any of the trial committee members. Please watch your children at all times, and do not allow them to approach any animals, including dogs, without permission. Be courteous to the exhibitors and stay a minimum of 20 feet away from the fences as you may startle the stock. All dogs must be on leash and visitors are asked to stay in the trial premises so as not to disturb resident dogs. Anyone not doing so will be asked to leave the premises.

From Edmonton:

From Hwy 216 (Anthony Henday) go west on Hwy 16A. Turn South on Hwy 60 towards Devon, Go 9.6 KM to Hwy 627. Turn West. Drive 24 KM to Range Road 15. Turn South. Drive 2.5 KM to Chasin' Dreams. Entrance is on the Left. There is a sign on the gate.

North on Hwy 2 to Hwy 19 (Nisku). Go west to Hwy 60. North into and through Devon. Continue to Hwy 627 (lights). East to Range Road 15 as above.
