Payment is due within **48** hours of the payment request being sent. Do not send payment prior to receiving a payment request. A waitlist will be started once capacity limits are reached.

ENTRY LIMIT: Tests are limited to 75 runs (25 entrants-all 3 components). Day of match entries may be accepted at this event, space providing. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added. Handlers will be entered in all 3 components in this match for the level(s) they are registering in.

MOVE UPS: There will be no move ups during this match.

EQUIPMENT: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season will be asked to run at the end. Please inform the Test Secretary before the day of the match.

TEST SITE CONDUCT: No indoor kennelling. These tests will be run rain or shine.

Dogs may be exercised on the west and south boulevards. Please do not potty them on the grass next to the building.

All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the match where off leash searches are permitted. All dogs must be contained in participant vehicles during the match. It is the participant's responsibility to ensure the dog(s) are secured by a means that does not allow the dog to 'get loose' from the vehicle (eg. crate, seat belt, harness). Dogs should not be able to hang their head or body outside of open windows or tailgates while in the vehicle.

It is the participant's responsibility to ensure their dog has the proper equipment to keep warm or cool in and out of the vehicle relevant to weather and season. Participants must keep their dogs at least 15 feet away from other dogs at all times when transporting to bathroom areas, warm up boxes or search areas. Failure to do so may result in a dismissal. <u>Flexi leads</u> will not be allowed on the test site.

Clean up after yourself and your dog.

Bathroom facilities are on site. There are restaurants within walking distance from the venue.
