All fees are in Canadian dollars and should be paid in that currency. If payments are made in USD, they must be for the full amount of the fees and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

PLEASE NOTE: When entering the same dog in multiple classes using a PAPER ENTRY FORM, a separate entry form MUST be filled out for EACH class.

Payment may be made online using a credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express) or by Interac or e-Transfer. Paper entries may be paid by cash or cheque made payable to SKOC.

GENERAL RULES & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Reserved Indoor Benching available for \$10 per 4x4 spot. Email l.shaw@sasktel.net starting October 4 to reserve. Payment will be through SKOC website. Ex-pens are not allowed. Set up available during mat time on Friday from 6-9 pm.
2. The catalogue will be available online at www.dogshow.ca.
3. There is no cafeteria on site.
4. Day of Trial Entries accepted IF limited entry not reached or vacancies available due to 'female in season' cancellations up to 1 hour before the start of each trial.
5. There will be **NO "In Transit"** area provided. Only dogs entered in official classes are permitted within the precincts of the trial (6.7.2).
6. There will be no "overnight" kenneling.
7. Please keep the building and grounds clean. Please pick up after your dog - an exercise area and clean-up materials will be provided.
8. Only approved CKC collars will be allowed in the precincts of the trials.
9. FEMALES IN SEASON: When a female comes into season after entries have closed, entry and listing fees will be refunded upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate confirming the female was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial if a veterinarian certificate is received by the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial.
10. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with their dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called.
11. Any dog entered and received at a trial must compete in all individual exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, superintendent, or the trial chair.
12. Eligibility to enter specific classes is detailed in the Obedience Trial & Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations. Entrants should review these requirements before entering the trials to ensure they are entered in the correct class. SHOWING correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. However, Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the "A" class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding "B" class up to 30 minutes before the start of the trial. The SKOC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.
13. The exhibitor or a representative must be present when prizes are awarded – SKOC will not take responsibility to deliver. All awards (except High in Class) will be given out at the end of each trial. All prizes will be awarded for qualifying scores only.
14. Every dog entered in an approved CKC trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration or Performance Event number; be eligible for registration with the CKC; have a Miscellaneous Certification number if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or, have a Canine Companion Number if a mixed or unrecognized breed.

15. THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the Saskatoon Kennel & Obedience Club (SKOC) located at 813G 51st St, Saskatoon, SK, building & grounds.
16. KNOWLEDGE of the current Canadian Kennel Club Rules is the responsibility of the entrant. Rule books may be obtained from the CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB, 5397 Eglinton Avenue W, Suite 101, ETOBICOKE, ON M9C 5K6, Telephone: 416-675-5511 or 1-855-364-7252.
17. The SKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators but will not be responsible for or assume any liability for loss or injury to any dog, exhibitor or spectator. If for any reason beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to complete the trials no refund of entry fees will be made.

DISCIPLINE

Section 20.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a trial held under the CKC Obedience and Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, however written or e-mail notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

PAYMENT & CLOSING TIME

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we are unable to accept any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time. Please allow for ample time for delays in the mail. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to the SKOC.

WAITLIST & DAY OF TRIAL ENTRY

If the entry limit is reached prior to closing, a waitlist will open and all further entries will be added in the order that entries are received. Entries onto the waitlist will close upon the closing of entries and the waitlist will terminate on October 24 at 8am – 24 hours prior to the starting time of the first trial. After this time, only day of trial entries will be accepted for time available in the schedule. Day of trial entries will be accepted for each trial up to one hour prior to the start of that trial and will be added in the order that they are received until the scheduled limit is reached.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

(Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation.
