If you are entering more than one dog, it is highly recommended you bring more hands. Volunteers will be limited; however, if you are unable to bring help to release your dog(s), please let us know upon your arrival so we can arrange for assistance.

These events are limited to 50 entries each.

Day of entries will be accepted if trials are not full. A stand-by list will be kept in accordance with CKC rules.

About the Event

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS:

Participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC or any of the following registrations with the CKC: Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN), Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN), Canine Companion Number (CCN), or Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event.

Event Day Information & Rules

Handler Briefing: 8:30AM Lameness Check-in: 8:45AM First Run: 9:00AM

There will be a fifteen-minute break between each run, and a longer break between the second and third run each day for lunch.

- The Event Secretary will be in full charge of events which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- Day-of entries will be accepted until 8:30AM and again during the lunch break before the final two runs of the day.
- Come prepared for rain or shine and bring plenty of water for you and your dog.
- Females in season are permitted to run; they will run last in each event and must wear snug-fitting panties.
- Lame or unfit dogs, (in the opinion of the inspection committee) will be excused, and their entry fee refunded.
- Muzzles and any well-fitting collar are permitted <u>except</u> for the following: Prong Collars, Chain Collars and Shock/E Collars. Dogs may also run 'naked'. Tags on collars must be taped up. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.
- We welcome all exhibitors. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your needs known to the club in advance.
- Catchers and releasers cannot travel more than 3M(10FT) past the start or finish line on either end. Going
 more than 10FT down the track will result in a <u>fail</u> and no time will be recorded. Please note, due to the use
 of laser timers you accept responsibility that you may affect your dog's time by crossing the start or finish before
 your dog reaches it.
- A white plastic bag, called a 'lure' is used to encourage the dog to run down the track, you may request that it not
 be run if your dog is not interested in or afraid of the lure. As long as there is no physical assistance, any means
 of getting your dog to run the track are allowed; these may include but are not limited to recall or retrieving an
 object thrown at the finish line by the catcher.
- A scoreboard is available at the end of the track for you to record your dog's time. Official results—including time, speed (km/hr), and points—will be posted on Dogshow.ca after each run. For your convenience, points will also be displayed on a whiteboard located near the secretary's tent.
- The Secretary will be available between runs for new title ribbons, qualifying flats & clarifying questions about the rules. For results, please refer to the above.
- Please clean up after yourself and your dog, there are garbage cans available on the field.
- Do not leave your dog unattended, tie-outs are not permitted.
- If a dog is found to be aggressive or out-of-control the owner may be asked to leave and their entry refunded.
- No dogs are permitted on the field at any time once a run has begun. Repeat offenders may be excused for the weekend with no refund.
- Fun runs or "Try-its" will be available immediately following each official run for \$10 per dog, each dog may run only once per fun run (four will be offered each day). Please register for fun-runs at the secretary table.

This is a physically intensive sport, please be sure to properly warm up and cool down your dog between runs.

Awards & Titles

EARNING POINTS:

The dog's time to complete the 100-meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

18" or greater - handicap is 1.25

12" up to less than 18" - handicap is 1.5

Below 12" - handicap is 2.0

Points - 360 divided by the dog's time produces the dog's KPH which is multiplied by the dog's handicap to result in the number of points earned. Example: a 14" tall dog takes 18 seconds to complete the course. 360/18 seconds = 20 KPH x 1.5 = 30 points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

Please be sure to enter the correct height category. Wickets will be available upon request.

By signing this document, you will waive certain legal rights, including the right to sue or claim compensation following an accident. Please read this document carefully.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the above-named dogs or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of acceptance of the entry and the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or prizes at the Sprinter events to be held on the dates listed above I agree:

- 1. To hold the Lloydminster Kennel and Obedience Club including their members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as "LKOC"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim;
 - 2. To hold LKOC harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of LKOC or any other person(s);
- 3. Assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save LKOC harmless from any and all loss and expense, including legal fees, by reason of the liability imposed by law upon the LKOC for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person(s), including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in the event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the LKOC or any other person(s);
