#### **VOLUNTEER POSITIONS**

<u>Volunteer Retriever/ Registration Desk Assistant/Runner:</u> The Volunteer Retriever goes and finds the volunteers for the next event as the course builders are building the course. Simply yelling names is not effect. You should actually speak to each volunteer and make sure that they know what job they were assigned. Assistant with registration. Takes score sheet(s) from the judge to the trial secretary to be recorded.

<u>Timer:</u> Start the timer for the competitor walk throughs and time competitor runs using electronic timing equipment. You will be responsible for timing the length of each run and reporting it to the scribe or scribe assistant. This person will also time the walk through for each event and blow the whistle at a pre-determined time to signal that the course is closed for walking.

<u>Judge Steward:</u> You will be responsible for keeping things moving by making sure the competitors are at the line ready to go when it's their turn. Responsible for getting competitors to the ring in a timely fashion.

<u>Course Builder(s)/Takedown:</u> Responsible for building and maintaining the course to the design specifications of the judge. Course builders also make sure the enclosure is secure and safe for competitors and dogs. We will need a minimum of three course builders. Course builders should be able to lift bales of straw.

#### **EVENT DESCRIPTIONS**

# **Lure Coursing**

This is a timed event in which the terrier chases a lure in an open course. The course is not fenced in, however the catch pen area is fenced in. Each class entry will include 2 runs. All runs must be run back to back. Enter as many times as you like, however, only your best of two runs will be considered for ribbon placement. All other runs considered fun runs.

#### Barn Hunt

With your help, your terrier must locate and work the rat in the barn/hay bales. Three to Four tubes will be placed among the hay bales; only one tube contains a rat. The handler/terrier team will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes to locate the rat. Timing starts when the terrier is released from the assigned starting area. Handlers may encourage/coach the terrier, but no touching is permitted.

# **Agility Tunnels**

This course consists of only open tunnels, which are taken in the order designated by the Judge. Refusals do not count, but taking the wrong end of the tunnel, popping out of the tunnel after entering or taking the wrong tunnel are all 5 faults. Scored by a combination of time and faults. New at this fun day, we will offer a "try it" tunnel class. If this is your first time with agility tunnels, and you have never tried or practiced it before, the "try it" class is for you. You have a two-minute time limit per run, for every tunnel your dog enters, you earn a point.

#### Ball Retrieval

This is a timed event in which the terrier works individually over distance. A line is marked off at 50 feet from the designated start. The ball must be tossed by the handler, or someone designated by the handler, to end up beyond the line. 3 throws only. Timing begins when the terrier crosses the start line toward the ball and it ends when the terrier returns to the start with the ball.

# Radical Recall

This is a timed event in which the terrier must return to the handler, first without distractions, second with distractions, and third with distractions when the handler is not visible. Each class entry will include 2 runs. All runs must be run back to back. Enter as many times as you like, however, only your best of two runs will be considered for ribbon placement. All other runs considered fun runs. An assistant to hold the dog back is recommended as the main handler will need to call the dog from the course.

#### **Brush Hunt**

This is a timed event in which the terrier uses its natural instincts outdoors to successfully locate and work the quarry above ground in a fully enclosed area. One encased quarry will be hidden within the brush area. No scent will be laid. The handler and terrier will start inside the fenced area, at the entrance gate. Timing begins when the terrier is released by the handler, who remains at the gate, until instructed by the judge.

#### Go To Ground

A timed event which stimulates the natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial 'den' to demonstrate its working ability by following the scent of the 'contained' rat at the end of the tunnel.

# Scent Detection Containers

This is a timed event where your dog, on leash, will search 10 containers and give an "alert" (a visual cue to the handler to indicate that their dog has found the correct location of the scent). For the introductory level there is one scent to alert (wintergreen).

<u>Fun Classes</u> (There is no entry fee and you'll win bragging rights.)

### Costume class (ages 18 and under)

With Halloween just around the corner, we have decided to add a little fun for everyone. Sponsored by Reidell Farms, there is no entry fee. It will be held during the lunch break and we welcome all children and their dogs to get creative. Everyone gets a prize with ribbons for the top 4, selected by our impartial judging team.

# Costume class (adults)

It will be held during the lunch break and we welcome all adults and their dogs to get creative. Everyone gets a prize with ribbons for the top 4, selected by our impartial judging team.

# Trick class (all ages)

Think your dog has a special talent? During the lunch break from our regular competition there will be a chance for you and your dog to be judged. Join the fun and show us what you've got. There is no entry fee and you'll win bragging rights.

#### **COVID RULES**

# Refunds:

There will be no refunds in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather. Refunds will be issued for bitches that come into heat, or dogs who are injured, providing the Trial Secretary receives a veterinarian's certificate at least 48 hours before the start of the trial. All entries must be "received by" or "postmarked by" the closing date.

# Facilities:

This is an outdoor event that will proceed rain or shine. We will have a porta potty on site.

# Awards:

Placement Ribbons for 1st through 4th will be available in each class.

## Dogs:

All dogs must be kept in an x-pen, crate or on leash when not in the ring. Handlers are responsible to clean up after their dogs

# Handlers:

Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, physically or verbally, while on site, will be asked to leave the trial grounds. There will be no refund of fees in such instances.
