Lions Foundation of Canada runs six Dog Guide programs: Canine Vision Canada, providing assistance to people who are blind or visually impaired; Hearing Ear Dogs of Canada, training Dog Guides for people who are deaf or hard of hearing; and Special Skills Dogs of Canada, providing Dog Guides to Canadians with physical or medical disabilities, Seizure Response Dog Guides, Dog Guides for children with Autism, and now for persons with Diabetes all at NO COST to those in need.
