
# Rally Obedience Intro and Coursework

**Rally Obedience** requires teamwork between dog and handler. Guided by signs, teams perform a series of obedience moves. Rally offers unique obedience exercises to challenge your dog!

#### Student Requirements - What To Bring:

- Your leash trained dog (puppies must be 6 months or older)
  - -Crate for your dog between turns (optional)
  - Soft, easy to break up treats that your dog loves
- Flat collar and 6 foot leash recommended (no flexi leashes)
