Helen Spacek Memorial Trophy awarded to Best In Specialty

In honor of a dear kind lady who was always generous with her help & knowledge and very patient with many of us as beginners. Helen was not new to raising dogs but new to Cairns in 1971. She was totally won over in no time & very convinced that all the Cairns really were "the best little pals in the world!" The picture of the Cairn on the trophy was Can.Am.Ch. MacSpacek Wee Bonni O'North, out of Helen's first litter (Ch. Cannycairns Fair Lady x Can.Am.Ch. Tycan's Ready-Or-Not). There were two in the litter & both became champions.

Barbara Hollings Memorial Trophy awarded to Best Puppy in Specialty

Barbara was a second generation Cairn breeder, becoming involved in her teenage years. She was an active member of The Cairn Terrier Club while in England. She moved to Canada in 1965 bringing Oona of Highhedges with her to continue with her breeding. She was one of the founding members of the CTCC. Many of the breeders today started with foundation stock from Barbara's "Highhedges" line.

Edna Perks Memorial Trophy awarded to Best of Winners

Edna purchased her first Cairn from Helen Spacek, McSpacek Wee Bonnie O'North. She chose Cairnorth for her kennel name and later, Crofter together with Joan McMurphy. Edna joined the CTCC in 1975 and helped form the Alberta Clan in 1987, with the result of the first Alberta regional specialty in 1988. She became a life member of the CTCC in 2000. It was no surprise that Edna became a licensed permit judge in 1990 and an All-Breed judge in 2004. Edna came full circle when 20 years after forming the Alberta Clan she judged the 2008 CTCC Regional Specialty. "She is fondly remembered."

EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These</u> Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or <u>unofficial classes</u> or Parades		

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", <u>or for Exhibition Only</u> to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require</u> an <u>ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST**. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF OBTAINING POINTS, AWARDS OR SCORES A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 20 – Dog Show Rules: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these dog show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder:

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 15 or more Points Awarded 2 3 4 5 0 1

*includes dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded WINNERS, total of all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with Championship Certificate the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at a breed or group level. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges, and be Individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a C.K.C. EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) and have 1 two point win from the Breed or Group level.
