ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Attention U.S. Exhibitors: A Personal cheque will be accepted, however, it must be payable in US funds and for the full entry amount. Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted. Do not mark cheque "payable in Canadian" or "funds at par". Your co-operation is appreciated.
2. If entering the same dog in conformation, obedience or exhibition only please use a separate entry form for each class.
3. An **INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORM WILL BE RETURNED**. Please ensure that your postal code is included. ALL NSF CHEQUES WILL BE CHARGED A \$30.00 SERVICE CHARGE.
4. Exhibitors must abide by the errors made when making the entry, regardless how or who made the entry.
5. An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees.
6. The Cobequid Dog Club reserves the right to reject any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. Only dogs, which are eligible for registration or are registered by the CKC, may be entered in these Show & Trials.
8. Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$5.00 will be considered a donation to CDC Trophy Fund.
9. The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC.
10. **There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue.**
11. Obedience Trial – Move Up A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Obedience Rules, may be moved to the next level of Obedience competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial secretary, **IN WRITING** by the owner or handler, 30 minutes prior to the opening of the first trial, trial schedule permitting.

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. **A Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to INDIGNITIES of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE PRECINCTS OF THE TRIAL WILL BE THE MAIN ARENA AREA.

The Trial Judging will start at 9:00am Unless entries warrant an earlier start. Judging schedule and identification will be mailed/mailed as soon as possible after the entry closing date. The Cobequid Dog Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required. The Trial Chairperson will be in full charge of the trials. **Only dogs entered in the trial are permitted within the trial precincts please.**

OFFICIAL JUNIOR HANDLING

There will be Junior Handling **OBEDIENCE** Saturday. Registration will be at the Event Secretary's table in the morning and must be done at **least one hour** in advance of the scheduled judging. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or in Exhibition Only. **A fee of \$2.00 for Junior Handling is required at time of registration.** Advanced notice of Obedience entry would be appreciated.

CLASSES

OBEDIENCE TRIAL OFFICIAL CLASSES: The following CKC official classes will be provided: Novice A, Novice B, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B, Pre-Novice, Novice C, Novice Intermediate.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM

THE C.K.C. or on the C.K.C. website

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly.

Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023**, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.

CKC HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:
Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.
At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.
