THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW IF THIS IS YOUR FIRST TRIAL?

You MUST have a valid Dog ID Number from AAC to compete for AAC qualifiers and titles. Dogs may enter and run FEO without a number.

Your dog will need to be measured by a judge Saturday and/or Sunday mornings.

CONFIRMATION: Confirmations will be emailed, or mailed to you if you don't provide an email address. If you do not receive a confirmation by 1 week prior to the trial date, or if there are errors, please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. This will help avoid delays on the day of the trial.

TRIAL SITE: This trial will be held outdoors on grass. Rain or Shine

CRATING & SET-UP: There will be plenty of space ring side for set up of shade tents etc. Please be aware that leaving valuables on-site overnight is at the risk of the owner. Weather can be unpredictable so don't leave anything onsite that you don't want to get wet.

AAC ID CARDS, CHECK IN AND MEASURING: If your dog does not have a completed AAC card, please order it well in advance (form enclosed) from AAC. You must have your dog measured and your card marked with that measurement before checking-in. Measuring will be available; Saturday & Sunday between 7:15 a.m.-7:30 a.m. Check in starting at 7:00 a.m. both days.

EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION / WALK THRU's: Starters dogs only; Contact equipment only. Saturday & Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. Sat/Sun Walk thru 7:50 a.m. throughout the weekend walk throughs may be split for bigger classes.

FIRST DOG ON THE LINE: Saturday & Sunday 8 a.m.

CLASS CHANGE/MOVE-UPS: Next day move-ups will be allowed. Please report move-ups to scorekeeping table. Move ups from prior trials must be reported no later than noon Friday, Aug 30 th 2013 - Please email Lisa Everson of any move ups immediately at lisaeverson@telus.net

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Flat ribbons will be awarded for1st through 4th Place. All Qualifying runs will receive an official Qualifying Rosette. MADC, ATChC, MSCDC, Bronze, Silver & Gold, will receive a large rosette.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and Paws Squad Canine Sports Club (the "Organizing Club") and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the "**Event**"), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

- 1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
- 2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
- 3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serous injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
- 4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:
 - (a) any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law: or
 - (b) aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.
- 5. I have read, and do understand the rules of competition and the additional rules (if any) appearing in the trial schedule for the Event, as well as the policies of AAC pertaining to discipline (collectively, the "Rules"). I agree to abide by the Rules and to conduct myself and the Dog in accordance with the Rules. I understand that myself and/or the Dog may be subject to disciplinary procedures or sanctions for breach of the Rules and agree to respect and be bound by any disciplinary decision made by AAC.
- 6. I understand that AAC and/or the Organizing Club may, in the course of administering the Event or conducting its activities generally, collect, use or disclose my personal information and that any personal information collected, used or disclosed by AAC and/or the Organizing Club will be treated in accordance with AAC policy and applicable privacy and personal

information laws. I hereby consent to the collection, use and disclosure by AAC and/or the Organizing Club of my personal information.

REMINDERS TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

This event is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may effect the dog's physical or mental performance, or any dogs showing signs of aggression.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC (rules are available online www.aac.ca).

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including during familiarization and course-walking. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.

All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.

Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great venue available to us and other dog clubs!

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made.

If an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.

There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.

AAC Starters Class: The starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

AAC Advanced Class: The advanced class shall be for dogs that having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

AAC Masters Class: The Masters class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada (MADC) title by the AAC, a dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges, and earn qualifying scores from 2 different judges in all 4 Advanced games.

AAC Veterans Class: These classes shall be for dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Standard Agility Class and for dogs five years of age or older who have competed in the Specials Agility Class for a minimum of one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in standard titling classes after being entered at an official trial in any Veteran class.

AAC Special Classes: These classes are open to all dogs but are intended for dogs that for any reason the handler elects that it is best for the dog to jump one jump height lower than the dog would at it's regular jump height. A dog may no longer compete in standard titling classes after being entered at an official trial in any Special class except that they may move to Veterans.

Games Titles & Progressions: One Starters game leg must be earned to progress in that game. Once a leg is earned in each game a Starters Games Dog title is earned. In Advanced games, 2 legs must be earned under two DIFFERENT judges in each game to earn an Advanced games Dog title. Once two qualifiers are earned in a game, the dog must enter Masters classes in that game. In Masters, 3 legs are required under two different judges to earn a Masters title in that game.
