All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid

ELIGIBILITY

All dogs must be four months to eighteen months of age to compete, and must be entered in one of the regular breed classes. Classes divided by Sex: 4 - 6 month / 6 - 9 months / 9 - 12 months / 12 - 18 months

PRIZES

1 – 4 in each age class......Ribbon (Flats)

FIRST in Each Class will compete for:

BEST in Sweeps	ROSETTE & 35% OF TOTAL ENTRY
SECOND in Sweeps	ROSETTE & 20% OF TOTAL ENTRY
THIRD in Sweeps	ROSETTE & 15% OF TOTAL ENTRY
FOURTH in Sweeps	ROSETTE & 10% OF TOTAL ENTRY

THE REMAINING 20% OF ENTRY WILL BE USED TO OFFSET THE COST OF THE SWEEPSTAKES

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

After Juvenile Sweeps JUDGE: Andrea Coughlan

Classes will be divided by Sex: 7 – 10 years of age/ 10 and over years of age

PRIZES

1 – 4 in each age class.....Ribbon (Flats)

FIRST in Each Class will compete for:

BEST in SWEEPS.......Rosette & 35% of total entry fees
BEST OF OPPOSITE.....Rosette and 20% of total entry fees
The remaining 25% of total entry collected remains with the Club to defray costs.

To enter Veterans sweepstakes the dog must be entered in one of the regular classes or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are entered in exhibition only.

SPECIALTY CLASSES

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered at all Specialties:

<u>Junior Puppy Class</u> - Dogs six (6) months of age and under nine (9) months of age on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy Class - Dogs nine (9) months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 to 18 Month Class - Dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred Class - Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded. *

*Different rules apply for the Best Canadian Bred in Specialty Award

<u>Bred By Exhibitor Class</u> - Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner **and** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards. *

Different rules apply for the Best Bred By Exhibitor in Specialty Award

Open Class - shall be for all dogs/bitches

<u>Veterans (competitive) Class</u> – Dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. The winners of each class in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

<u>Specials Only Class</u> - Dogs that have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for championship status.

The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary one hour prior to the opening of the show on the day concerned.

<u>Award Of Merit</u> - At the judge's discretion, one Award of Merit may be presented for every ten (10) dogs competing for Best of Breed.

<u>Best Veteran in Specialty</u> - dogs must be entered in the Veteran's class.

<u>Best Canadian Bred in Specialty</u> - as per the CKC rule book, eligibility for Best Canadian Bred includes ALL dogs that were born in Canada, not just those entered in the Canadian Bred classes. This includes Specials. All Canadian-bred dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another Canadian-bred dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. In the event that Best of Breed is also Canadian Bred, obviously "Best Canadian Bred" would be awarded to the Best of Breed winner.

<u>Best Puppy in Specialty</u> - All dogs under 12 months of age that have not been either directly or indirectly defeated by another puppy in the breed or had an award withheld, are eligible for Best Puppy in Specialty. The dogs need not be entered in the puppy class (this includes any puppy that is entered as a special).

<u>Best Bred By Exhibitor in Specialty</u> - This is a special award donated by THIS show committee, and unlike American Specialties, it is not a regular category. The eligibility and judging criteria is essentially the same as for Best Canadian Bred, with the obvious difference of the handler/breeder requirements, not the country of birth. If the BREEDER of the dog (not necessarily the owner) was also the HANDLER throughout the Specialty, he/she is eligible to compete. The dog does NOT have to be entered in the Bred-by class.

Exhibition Only - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular Class but may be entered and compete in any Non-Regular Classes.

BABY PUPPY CLASS (Unofficial Classes)

This is a non-regular class open to Dogs & Bitches four (4) months of age and under six (6) months of age on the day of the show. No points are awarded to Baby Puppies. Placements are awarded first through fourth for each sex with Best Baby Puppy Male and Best Baby Puppy Female awarded respectively. Immediately thereafter a Best Baby Puppy in Specialty is chosen. (Unlike the 6-9 month puppies, the Baby puppies are not required to enter the ring after Best of Breed.)

Printed on the Baby Puppy Class Judging Form is the following note: "Judges should not disqualify dogs in this class for lack of testicles or not meeting a minimum height requirement required in the breed standard."

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

The following Non-Regular CKC Classes are offered by this Specialty Club:

<u>Sire & Get</u> – shall be for Sire and two (2) or more of his Get. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

*Get or Progeny MUST be entered in one of the Regular official classes at the Specialty. The Stud Dog MUST also be entered in one of the Regular official classes at the Specialty, or for Exhibition Only. Stud Dogs are judged on the merits of their PROGENY. Regardless of his appearance, a good sire will produce quality and consistency. The sire or dam should not even be gaited. The stud and brood

are awarded on their apparent reproductive ability, not their physical stature, and are the only dogs in the ring to carry arm bands. Each sire or dam must have a minimum of 2 progeny.

<u>Brood Matron & Progeny</u> – shall be for Dam and 2 or more of her Progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

*Get or Progeny MUST be entered in one of the Regular official classes at the Specialty. The Brood Matron MUST also be entered in one of the Regular official classes at the Specialty, or for Exhibition Only. Brood Matrons are judged on the merits of their PROGENY. Regardless of her appearance, a good dam will produce quality and consistency. The sire or dam should not even be gaited. The stud and brood are awarded on their apparent reproductive ability, not their physical stature, and are the only dogs in the ring to carry arm bands. Each sire or dam must have a minimum of 2 progeny.

<u>Brace Class</u> – shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex), judged as a matched pair. A brace must be handled by one person on one lead. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow or a mirror image of each other.

<u>Sexually Altered Classes</u> - eligibility for the Altered Classes is limited to dogs over 6 months of age that have been spayed/neutered by veterinary procedure. These classes are only offered at Specialties. Points MAY NOT be carried from the Regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. These classes WILL be judged upon the completion of the Regular Specialty judging.

*<u>Altered Male</u> and <u>Altered Female</u> – Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes; the first place winner from each sex will be declared WINNERS and the second place winner from each sex RESERVE. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered and Best Opposite Sex Altered In Breed.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class Dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN).

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship. All required points are to be earned at the breed level. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include one Best of Breed and a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed Winner and the number of similar sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013. Points earned toward the Grand Champion title are to be recorded by the owner/handler on the form obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. Once the owner/handler believes that their exhibit has attained the requirements for the Grand Champion title, the form may be submitted to the Canadian Kennel Club for verification and awarding of the title.

<u>Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)</u> The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.

The Hyacinth Mellish Challenge Trophy for Best Of Winners - donated by Gladys Tangen & Martha Beswick. To be won outright when won 3 times by the same owner, but not necessarily the same dog. A keeper trophy shall be presented.

NOTES

For the award of Best Veteran in Specialty, dogs must be entered in the Veteran's class.

For the award of <u>Best Canadian Bred in Specialty</u>, all Canadian bred dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another Canadian bred dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. The dog does not need to be entered in the Canadian-bred class.

For the award of <u>Best Puppy in Specialty</u>, all puppies 6 month and under 12 months on the day of the show, having not been defeated directly or indirectly by another puppy shall be eligible to compete for this award. The dog does not need to be entered in the puppy class.

For the award of <u>Best Bred By Exhibitor in Specialty</u>, all breeder/owner handled dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another breeder/owner handled dog shall be eligible to compete for this award. The dog does not need to be entered in the Bred By Exhibitor class, but must have been handled solely by the breeder(s)/owner(s) throughout the entire Specialty show.

Awards of Merit – awarded at the discretion of the Judge (one per 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed).

PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS & VETERANS

Non-Competitive. Not held under the auspices of the Canadian Kennel Club; Further entries are not required.

*** For this year's Specialty, we will also be offering "In Memory Of" rosettes for our beloved Veterans and Titleholders who crossed the Rainbow Bridge, and never got a chance to be honoured in person (dog). The owners/breeder of the dogs will be presented the rosette in person and may, if they wish, share a special memory/anecdote/accomplishment. ***

If you would like a lovely rosette to commemorate the achievements of your dog thus far, you may enter your dog under the Parade of Titleholders. You will receive a beautiful rosette with your dog's name and titles embossed. It is a small price to pay for such a nice and personal keepsake, and it supports the Club.

Cost to enter is \$30.

Parade entrants MAY be spayed or neutered. For this Parade we invite all Mastiffs aged 7 and up (Veterans); and any Mastiff that holds any title for which a certificate has been awarded (e.g. any Championship, Obedience, Rally, Draft Dog, Agility, Weight Pull, Canine Good Neighbour/Citizen or Temperament tests), and any other working title.

To encourage participation and acknowledgement of each dogs' accomplishment, this award is not restricted to CKC events alone! A brief description including the dog's registered name and titles, date of birth, call name, owner's name and brief summary of dog's achievements will be printed in the Specialty Catalogue.

Parade entries can be paid for through the dogshow.ca website.

Deadline to enter the Parade and submit your dog's write-up is October 1, 2024.

***Please note... due to rosette sourcing issues, names of all dogs being entered for the Parade of Veterans, Parade of Titleholders, or Rescue Parade must be submitted by email: bendeqeitmastiffs@hotmail.com NO LATER than midnight, September 25, 2024. Names submitted after this time, will receive their rosettes after the show. ***







Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- 2. A dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian for any reason shall not, compete in any Class for any awards for balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
- 4. Dogs must be on the grounds 1-hour prior to the judging of their breed. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering the dog
- 5. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
- 6. Dogs to be exercised in designated areas only, not in vicinity of rings
- 7. All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the health department and may be subject to a fine.
- 8. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry.
- 9. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building with the exception of the obedience rings
- 10. These events have a zero bullying policy! You can and will be removed with out refund of fees if you are found to be bullying!
