**Please note: ALL PERSONS WHO ENTER THE GROUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER PRIOR to ENTERING OR ENGAGING IN ANY ACTIVITIES ON THE GROUNDS..** This is the requirement of the landowner.

No filming or video taping of this event is permitted without the express written permission of the Field Trial Committee. No footage obtained may be used for commercial purposes or for posting on any Social Media sites.

**Courses and Birds:** Native Hungarian partridge, pen raised pheasants, partridge or quail. The Open Puppy will be single course, with no birds released and no bird field. All other stakes will be run on a single course with birds released on the back course only. At the discretion of the Field Trial Committee courses may be added, deleted or altered to accommodate as many dogs as possible. A bird field may be added should conditions warrant.

## **LOCATION**

Directions will be provided with entry confirmation. The club is grateful to have the use of these grounds and asks for your cooperation in keeping them free of litter by using garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the designated camping areas. Camping on the grounds will be allowed from 4pm September 3rd until 6pm September 6<sup>th</sup> 2021. Training and running of dogs on the grounds will not be permitted immediately before, during or after the trial. Hay must be removed from grounds upon departure.

**The GSPFCA is grateful to Jim and Sue Deyell for the use of these grounds. Please respect and abide by all good neighbour rules. Please clean up all garbage before leaving no matter how small.**

**MOST IMPORTANT: NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE. THIS AREA IS EXTREMELY DRY AND SENSITIVE TO THE SMALLEST SPARK. PLEASE RESPECT THE LAND OWNERS WISH AND ABIDE BY THIS RULE.**

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Running and Handling:** Handling will be done on foot only. Only judges, Marshall's and bird planters may be mounted.

**Tracking collars:** The GSPFCA is allowing the use of electronic tracking collars in the trial. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. Participants must declare that they are using the tracking collars to the Field Trial Chairman and also to the judges. Only Garmin GPS collars that are approved for use in Canada and will be permitted. **NOTE:** as per rule 11.4.10 With the exception of tracking collars, collars to be worn in competitive stakes must be a type solely used for purposes of identification. That is, the normal dog collar with name plate attached **or** coloured collars used to distinguish between dogs in a brace. 11.6.6 states that no more than two collars may be worn by a dog.

**Collaring:** Collaring a dog away after contact with game **will** be allowed.

**Blank Pistols:** .22 calibre or larger will be fired over all dogs with bird work in senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols will not be fired in the puppy stake.

**Total Entries:** Entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours as determined by the committee

Senior and Derby stakes are 30 min. and the Puppy stake will be 20 min. length. In order to accommodate as many dogs as possible in the event of a large entry, or any other unforeseen circumstances, a 20 min Derby stake and a 15 min. Puppy Stake may be run. At the discretion of the Committee, stakes may be rearranged or courses altered to accommodate as many entries as possible. This includes the addition of a birdfield.

**Bitches in season:** Bitches in season **will** be allowed to run in **Amateur Shooting Dog and Open Puppy only.**

**All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and Regulations** and also the rules, conditions, and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial Rules are available from the CKC.

## **ACCOMMODATIONS**

Camping will be allowed on the grounds in the area specified. Please do not leave the trail with your vehicles while driving on the pasture. Facilities are limited, come prepared. Outhouse is provided. Cochrane motels: Bow River Inn – (403) 932-7900; Cochrane Super 8 – (403) 932-6355

#### **TCN FEE**

**IMPORTANT CHANGE: TCN Number: (Previously Listing fees)** A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) has been established by The Canadian Kennel Club and MUST ACCOMPANY the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This fee is \$10.50 (incl GST) per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records. Please visit [www.CKC.ca](http://www.CKC.ca) to obtain your TCN

#### **IMPORTANT!! READ THIS**

All entries for this Field Trial are accepted on condition that the GSPFCA, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by animal or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field trial. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian. All persons attending this field trial as participant or visitor will be required to sign a landowner waiver. For those entering this is contained on your entry form.

## COVID 19

Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic the club will be adhering to all recommended guidelines in the Province of Alberta. Since this is an outdoor event masks will not be mandatory but please respect the physical distancing guidelines and other people's space. We highly recommend showing up, running your dog and leaving.

General guidelines to consider:

1. Practice physical distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
2. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others. The Club will provide masks if desired for officials, judges and volunteers
3. Wash hands as frequently as possible. We will have disinfecting spray and/or wipes at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
4. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
5. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Things to remember:

1. There will be no hospitality available (thanks COVID-19).
2. Bring water and food for yourself and your dogs.
3. The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the trial grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicle.
4. If your dog poops, please scoop and dispose in the provided garbage bags or consider packing out your own refuse.

**Most importantly if you are experiencing any Covid 19 symptoms PLEASE STAY HOME!!**
