- Barn Hunt Registration Number and Barn Hunt Rules and Regulations may be obtained on the website, www.barnhunt.com.
- Entries made without fees or signature and a completed Waiver and Indemnity Form will not be accepted.
- If you provide your email address, we will acknowledge receipt of your entry via email within a few days. If you do not receive an initial confirmation within one week of submitting your entry, contact the Trial Secretary. Any errors must be reported to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of the trial.
- Entry fee(s) will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. - All dogs must be on a short leash (6') and under control at all times, while on trial grounds, except when in the ring for judging. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dog must run "naked," without a collar/harness. The actual course area will be securely enclosed. No flexi-leads or head halters allowed within the show building. Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site this includes electronic bark collars. Prong collars may be used on the site while walking dogs, but are not allowed while the dog is competing.
- Bitches in season may compete. They will run at the end of each class. They must wear "pants" at all times when not being pottied, including on the course. Owners of bitches in season should confine their dog(s) away from the trial area and other dogs, post "dog in season" signs in their area, and potty their dog(s) away from other competitors. Owners should make their condition known to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trials and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.
- The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class because the
