Covid-19 Safety Protocol for Champlain KC 2020 Shows

If you cannot comply with these rules <u>Do Not Enter or Attend!</u>

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN IT IS POSSIBLE.

<u>Waiver must be signed</u>, by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Vendors, Family Members, Friends etc.

Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number)

<u>Masks Must be worn correctly over mouth & nose this is</u> <u>(Mandatory)</u> by Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards in the rings during judging.

Each ring will have **an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers.** Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring, **NO RECYCLING** of ribbons.

Masks Must be Worn correctly over mouth & nose this is (Mandatory) under the tents/pavilion, in Washrooms, in any other location where 2 meters - 6ft cannot be maintained.

Social Distancing 2 meters-6ft this is (Mandatory)

in the rings, under the tents, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Dog Show is NOT OPEN to the General Public.

<u>Show Site Access Process:</u> Waiver is to be handed into the club upon arrival at show site, attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only.

The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations, there will be a "limited" supply of masks in case someone needs one.

Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently.

No Public Catalogue will be available, know your numbers when picking up armbands.

Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks.

<u>Do not</u> leave personal belongings at ringside.

<u>Do not</u> leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.

Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

IF YOU SEE SOMETHING – SAY SOMETHING! HELP US PROTECT EVERYONE. PLEASE DO NOT CONFRONT AN INDIVDUAL VIOLATING SAFETY RULES, Contact the Show Superintendent or Club Official.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Due to restrictions laid out by the province, all exhibitors must remain in their vehicles at all times other than for the purpose of exhibiting your dog.
- Dogs cannot be groomed outside of your vehicle anywhere on site.
- Exhibitors will be lined up according to their ring and will advance to the ring area when instructed. Vehicles will be escorted to the ring area by a pilot. No exceptions!
- ➤ We need 100% cooperation from everyone.
- ➤ Any deviation from 100% compliance will result in ejection from the show without refund.
- The Champlain Dog Club, its members and volunteers thank you for helping us in these trying times.
- > The health department, humane society as well as bylaw officers may arrive at the venue at any time without notice.
- Those who attended the last Wildwood shows know the drill. Please pass it on so that we can have another successful show.
